




INTRODUCTION: In the last lesson, we started discussing the way out of the consequences of the fall of man. Today, we shall continue our discussion on it as we consider the reconciliation work.

WAY OUT OF THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE FALL OF MAN

CONCLUSION: Because the perfect man died for our death, God counts us dead. The penalty paid is the basis of forgiveness.



THE REQUIREMENTS OF SERVANTHOOD

Luke 19:1-9

In sending his son to earth, God didn't intend for Him to be a superstar. Jesus came to serve. As His disciples, we are to follow His example and serve a lost and hurting world. In today's passage, we read about Zacchaeus, who began to demonstrate qualities he saw Jesus model.

Awareness:

Although surrounded by a crowd, the Lord stopped and took notice of one particular man perched in a tree. Zacchaeus was hated and rejected because he was a tax collector. Although he was rich, there was something missing in his life, and Christ recognized his need.

In our life, there are many people like Zacchaeus—needy, empty, lonely, and searching for hope. But too often, we're preoccupied with our activities and don't even notice them.

Availability:

Jesus was heading to Jerusalem to carry out the most important act in human history: our redemption. Yet He stopped to spend time with a spiritually needy man. What is so important that it keeps you from giving people your time and attention?

Acceptance:

Although Zacchaeus was a notorious sinner, Jesus didn't say, "Clean up your act, and then I'll come to your house." We're called, not to fix people, but to share the transforming gospel of Christ.

How are you doing at serving those around you? Maybe it's time to slow down enough to see who might be in need.

God places all kinds of opportunities in our path, but if we're not attentive, we'll miss them.

Sometimes we just need to pause, pray, and open our eyes.

The phrase "do not be afraid" is written in the bible 365 times. That's a daily reminder from God to live every day being fearless.

The Parable of the Twins

Together the twins explored their world. When they found their mother's cord that gave them life they sang for joy, "how great is our mother's love that she shares her own life with us."

As the weeks stretched into months the twins noticed how much each was changing.

"What does this mean?", asked the one.

"It means that our stay in this world is drawing to an end", said the other one.

"But I don't want to go", said the one, "I want to stay here forever"

"But there has to be", protested the other. "How else did we get here? How do we remain alive?"

"Have you ever seen our mother?", said the one. "Maybe she lives in our minds. Maybe we made her up because the idea made us feel good."

And so the last days in the womb were filled with deep questioning and fear and finally the moment of birth arrived.

When the twins had passed from their world, they opened their eyes and cried, for what they saw exceeded their fondest dreams.

Christ is My Life

What happened when we were saved? God took us out of Adam and put us into Christ. We were cut off from Adam and "grafted" into Christ.

To graft a branch means to take it out of one vine and join it to another vine. The branch is cut away from the old vine. Then a cut is made in the new vine, and the branch is fitted into this cut place and securely wrapped.



Soon something wonderful happens. The life of the new vine begins to flow through the branch. The branch is now sharing the life of the new vine, and it begins to bear its fruit. From this we can see what a wonderful thing God did for us. God took us out of Adam and "grafted" us into Christ.

The Bible says, "Of Him [God] are you in Christ Jesus...." 1 Corinthians 1:30 We are now joined to the Lord Jesus in a living way. He is our new Vine, and we are living branches in Him. We share His life.



The Bible says that we are "partakers [sharers] of the divine nature [Christ's life]" (2 Peter 1:4).

• The vine is in the branch. Not only is the branch in the vine, but the very life of the vine, the sap, is in the branch. This is what keeps the branch alive and causes it to bear fruit.

This teaches us that not only are we *in Christ*, but Christ is in us. We have the very life of Christ in us.

The secret of the Christian life

The secret of the Christian life is that Christ is my life. Christ is not outside of me as my Helper; He lives in me. The apostle Paul said,

"For to me to live is Christ [His life in me]...." Philippians 1:21

Paul did not say, "I am trying to imitate Christ." He did not say, "I am going to do the best I can and ask the Lord to help me." He said, "For to me to live is Christ" [His life in me]. Christ does not want to be my Helper; He wants to be my life.

If we see a branch loaded down with beautiful grapes, we might ask the branch, "How did you bear all this beautiful fruit? What is the secret?" If the branch could talk, it would say, "The secret is that the life of the vine flows in me. Everything I need is in the vine. I depend on the vine for everything."

The Lord Jesus wants us to learn the lesson of the vine and the branches. He is our "vine," and we are "branches" in Him. Everything that we need is *in Christ* and we have His life flowing in us.



LAST WORD

You may not see yourself that way, but that doesn't change GOD's image of you. GOD still sees you exactly as His Word describes you.

Dare to start seeing yourself as GOD sees you - as a victor!


