

INTRODUCTION:



In the last lesson, we started looking at the purpose of creating human being. Today, we shall continue from where we stopped.

THE PURPOSE OF CREATING HUMAN BEING II

- As God created man in His image, which we discussed in the last lesson as quality of His being; He also created man in His own likeness. God's likeness indicates the attributes of God's character. The likeness of God we are created with are:
 - Good work. Ephesians 2:10
 - Righteousness
 - Holiness. Ephesians 4:23-25

A BARRIER TO ENJOYING GOD

Romans 6:12-15

Several years ago I counselled a woman who was consumed by bitterness toward her father. He had abandoned the family and refused to acknowledge her as his daughter.

Then he became ill and sought to make amends, but the woman refused to hear him. She clung to that unforgiving spirit for many years after her father died.

When she finally repented, she told me that the burden of her bitterness had kept her from enjoying God.

One of the Holy Spirit's roles is to make believers aware of attitudes and actions that are contrary to God's will.

If we decide to resist conviction, we will naturally try to quiet the Spirit's voice—which often means giving the Lord less of our time or none at all.

Then unconfessed sin will cause us to walk away from the Father instead of delighting in our relationship with Him.


Sin usually feels good in some way—temporarily. For example, we can feel justified in our bitterness when the other person has wronged us. Sometimes we want to hold on to resentment and prolong our sense of validation.

But as believers, we cannot run our life by emotion. We must consider God's truth: The Bible says that if we refuse to confess and repent, sin will enslave our heart and destroy our testimony.

Satan tempts us with sins that are likely to look and feel good to our natural self—a habit that gives pleasure or solace is easier to justify than one that seems repulsive.

But no sinner is truly happy chasing after wickedness. Authentic joy is found only in oneness with the Lord.

So many times, when our prayers are not answered immediately, we get tired of praying for the same thing over and over and we stop praying. Yet the Bible says we should "pray without ceasing" (1 Thessalonians 5:17). We have to persevere in prayer till we get an answer and achieve success, total recovery and restoration.

Lesson 9: Christ or Self?

After becoming a Christian, sooner or later I make a shocking discovery. I discover that sin is still with me. I have an enemy in me called "the flesh." The flesh is very sinful.

The "flesh" is not my body itself, but the sinful nature that dwells in my body. If you spell the word "flesh" backwards and leave off the "h," what do you have? You have S-E-L-F. The flesh is SELF!

The main characteristic of SELF is rebellion against God. SELF says, "I will do what I want to do!" Where did we get this spirit of rebellion? We got it from Adam. Where did Adam get it? He got it from Satan!



Satan was the first rebel. Satan said in his heart, "I will have my own way!" Then Adam rebelled against God and said in his heart, "I will have my own way!" Now you and I say in our heart, "I will have my own way!" By nature we are all like this. The Bible says, "...we have turned everyone to his own way..." (Isaiah 53:6).

When I was saved I became a new person in Christ, but I did not get a new body. I still have the same body I had when I was unsaved, and I still have the sin nature which goes with that old body. But the good news is that God does not count this sin nature against me. Only when I do what my sin nature wants me to do does it become sin.

What happened when I took Christ as my Saviour? Before I was saved, this enemy SELF was on the throne of my heart. I was ruled by SELF. I thought and said things like this:

"Me first!"

"I don't have to obey you!"

"I want to do it my way!"

"I don't care what you say!"

"I hate you!"

"I don't care what God says; I will do what I want to do!"



When I was saved, another Person came to live in my heart. The Lord Jesus Himself came to live in me. I was so happy. I thought my life would always be happy and peaceful. I thought I would always want to please God and obey Him.

But I soon discovered that SELF wants to continue ruling in my heart. Christ has the right to rule, but SELF still tries to rule me. I must choose whether I will be ruled by Christ or SELF.





