


### LESSON XIV. THE PRACTICAL RESULTS OF HIS COMING

(c) Holy Spirit infilling is necessary for a day-to-day victory in the believer's life for:


- I. Indwelling sin. Gal. 5:16






## The Landmine of Jealousy

### Be Still & Know: We have a priceless inheritance

I am greatly helped when thinking of blessing, both as an act of praise to God (and therefore to "bless God") and as a receiving of help from God through the prayers of the Church (the act of giving and receiving blessings).

It is in these ways that we "become blessings" for one another and offer blessings to God – by living true to who God has made us as his people.

Learning to give thanks, to bless God and others, in seasons of plenty and seasons of want, gives a positive appreciation of God in all of life. That positive foundation becomes essential when life puts the squeeze on us.

Ultimately, our destiny, as todays scripture reminds us, is secure because of Jesus Christ. It is on these nursery slopes of our mortal life that we gain the experience for the mountain of eternity. All of our life can only make sense in light of our eternal objective. It's not that we are being too heavenly minded to be of any earthly use; instead, we are discovering how to live with heaven in our heart – through all the complexities life serves up.

Discipleship requires a lot of letting go of the human drives that we might assume hold our lives together and direct our steps. We are to seek God's presence in every moment of our life, and in doing so we discover fresh fuel to bless God. The manna, the miraculous provision of food for the Israelites in the desert ([Exodus 16](#)), was never a series of ready meals safely stacked within the freezer against a rainy day. It was fresh every morning, just like the "steadfast love" of God ([Lamentations 3:22-23, ESV](#)).

### AWAKENING

"You reach a point where you feel yourself going through an awakening. You look at what you used to do and who you used to be. It hurts because you realize you believed in and promoted non-sense. You grow; you evolve and you stop because you no longer operate at that frequency. As a result, there's certain people that you have to walk away from. As a result, you start to realize just how messed up the world is. You want to help; you want to heal; you want to make it a better world. This is how you know you're awakening a higher level of consciousness..."

## TURN BACK TO GOD

### Know More About God's Plan For You



**What is God's plan for you?** To know his plan for you, you need to ask him what the rich young man once asked him – Luke 18:18 – ‘Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?’ God’s plan for you or rather his ultimate objective for you is eternal life. **It is to lead you to eternal life that God plans every aspect of your life.** He plans everything – right from the kind of skills you require to your vocation, family, environment and even your flaws and failures.

### God's Plan For Many

God blessed Saul with tremendous oratory skills so that Saul, after becoming Paul, could use this skill to proclaim Christ to the Gentiles and thereby gain eternal life. Zacchaeus the chief tax collector was given a flaw to contend with in his earthly life so that he could gain entry to eternal life. The flaw was that God created him as a man of short stature. Had he not been of short stature he would not have climbed the sycamore tree to catch a glimpse of Jesus and subsequently not have had Jesus come to his house. The Patriarch Abraham was given a failure in life by giving him no child. Ultimately it is this failure that increased his faith in God to such an extent that led him to be called as the Father of Faith and consequently to eternal life. David’s vocation was transformed from that of a Shepherd to a King. This was God’s way of calling David into a fellowship with him and thereby leading King David to eternal life. Moses was ordained by God to live in the family of the Pharaoh despite being a Hebrew. Had he not been found by the Pharaoh’s daughter he would have been slaughtered. In the case of Moses it was the Pharaoh’s family that triggers his path to eternal life. Later on the family that he was born into becomes the cause of his flight to the desert where he encounters God and is commissioned for the mission of leading the Israelites to the land of milk and honey.

John 17:3 gives us the definition of eternal life as taught by Jesus’. In a nutshell, eternal life is nothing but a personal relationship with the Trinitarian God – The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit.

This experience is very evident in the life of a number of people who pursued Christ. In Mark 10:46-48 ‘we see the crowd following Jesus trying to prevent Bartimaeus from calling him for help. This is what the world or the people around us always try to do. They will always prevent us from approaching Jesus for help. In such a situation, it is for us to swim against the tide and say NO to the world around. Imagine what would have happened to Bartimaeus had he listened to the crowd? It was because Bartimaeus dealt appropriately with the crowd that he came to know Jesus (eternal life).

Zacchaeus the chief tax collector had to deal with his greed for wealth en-route to eternal life. The woman who suffered from haemorrhage for twelve years had to deal with the crowd before approaching Jesus. Saul after his Damascus experience and before he was commissioned to be the apostle of the Gentiles, had to deal with his pride and ignorance concerning Jesus before God could use him.

### Away From Sin

Therefore, being Sin conscious and dealing with our sins is just as essential a step in the direction of the revelation of God’s plan for us as is breaking away from the crowd and practicing detachment with the world.

**We need to identify which of the seven cardinal sins** viz. anger, greed, sloth, pride, lust, envy and gluttony or a combination of them is/are ruling us and systematically eliminate them before we can think of practicing detachment.

Ephesians 1:9-10 has this to say ‘For he has made known to us in all wisdom and insight the mystery of his will, according to his purpose which he set forth in Christ. 10 As a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth’.

To know more about the will of God, practice 1 Thessalonians chapter 5 16-18 – ‘Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.’

### OVERCOMERS

**How did the universe come into being?**

**God created it!** The very first sentence in the Bible says, “*In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth*” (Genesis 1:1). No one knows when God created the heavens and the earth.



God created the universe, but He has told us how He created it. He spoke it into being.

God said, “*Let there be...*” and instantly, it came into being. The Bible says,

“*By the word of the Lord were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth... For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast*” (Psalm 33:6, 9).

The word “create” means to make something out of nothing. There was no “cosmic material” in space before God spoke. The Bible says, “*Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear*” (Hebrews 11:3). God created all things.



God created the earth by itself, and neither did the earth. God said, “*I have made the earth and created man upon it...*” (Isaiah 45:12).

The living creatures on the earth did not evolve from some miraculous, single cell of life over a period of billions of years. God created them!

**God created many different kinds of birds, fish, and animals.** God told all the living creatures to “*be fruitful and multiply after their kind.*” This is God’s law of reproduction. Every living creature produces offspring or babies like itself.

**Where did we come from?**

**We came from God.** The universe is not an “accident,” and neither are we. God created the universe, and He created the first man. The Bible says, “*The Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul [a living person]*” (Genesis 2:7).

**God's most wonderful creation is man.** Man did not come up from lower forms of life. Man was created as a “*living person.*” Man is not God, nor a part of God, but he is the highest of all God’s creatures because he was created “*in the image of God.*” The Bible says, “*So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them*” (Genesis 1:27).

"God led me to speak to them on your behalf" I said

"You did what?"

"God led me to do what you have not been able to do by yourself" I said.

"You are still not answering my question, what did you do?" he said in a fury.

I moved away from him... "I showed them a video Pastor Maggie had made to destroy you."

"What video?" He was literally shaking in anger.

"Give me some minutes" I ran up the stairs and brought the flash drive which I inserted into the USB Port of the Television. 

# LAST WORD


