

# **SUNDAY SCHOOL** THE MANIFESTATION GIFTS VII

**TEXT:** Acts 2:1-5

## **MEMORY VERSE:**

**"And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. "Acts 2:4 NKJV**

Jesus said:

And these signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues.

Mark 16:17

## **INTRODUCTION:**

In the last lesson, we concluded the discussion on the gift of revelation (or thought). Today, we shall begin treating the second category of manifestation gifts, which is the gift of speech (or words), beginning with the manifestation of tongues.

## **LESSON IV. THE GIFTS OF SPEECH (OR WORDS)**

The gifts of speech enable the believer to speak, pray and worship God in Spirit and truth. They are means by which we can put into words that which is upon the heart and mind of God. The gifts in this category are tongues, interpretation of tongues and prophecy.

### **a) THE MANIFESTATION OF TONGUES**

#### **i. DEFINITION OF MANIFESTATION OF DIVERS OF TONGUES**

- It is the ability the Holy Spirit gives to the recipient of the gift to speak in another tongue or language, which the speaker does not know and has not learned by the speaker.
- It is a divinely given speech in the form of sounds (not just sounds) and languages unknown to the speaker but to the heavens.
- These languages will be one spoken somewhere on earth or that of the angels (I Cor. 13:1) but maybe unknown to the hearers within the congregation.

#### **ii. THE PURPOSE OF THIS GIFT**

Speaking in tongues was the open sign of the Holy Spirit coming upon the new believers on the Day of Pentecost. However, speaking in tongues is more than just a sign of the Holy Spirits, presence in our lives, speaking in tongues serves four (4) main purposes or functions:

1. It is a sign of being baptized with the Holy Spirit. Acts 2:1-5, 19:1-7
2. It is a grace (divine enablement) for our edification in our prayer life. I Cor. 14:4
3. It is a gift (with interpretation) to edify the body of Christ. I Cor. 14:22.
4. It is a sign to those who do not believe (carnal believer). I Cor. 14:22.



They took up stones to kill Him. They said, "...you, being a man, make yourself God." Why was Jesus crucified? He was hated and crucified because He claimed to be God.


### 3. Must be sinless.

Many people hated Jesus when He was here on earth. The religious leaders hated Him because He claimed to be God. They tried to trip Him up in His words, but Jesus asked them, "Which of you convinces [convicts] Me of sin?" (John 8:46). No one could point to a single sin in his life.

Jesus never had to apologize to anyone because He never wronged anyone. He was sinless. Speaking of His Father, He said, "...I do always those things that please Him" (John 8:29). Twice the Father spoke from Heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son in whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17; 17:5).

## TURN BACK TO GOD

### How Ready Are You To Start Something New?



Some love to start something new while some others hate the very thought of it! Personally, I enjoy new stuff – whether it's travelling through a new road, launching a new project or tasting a new dish.

**But before taking the big leap on to the new venture, it will be good if you could evaluate your motive against these 5 essential questions:**

#### 1. Am I emotionally-driven or purpose-driven?

Emotions can play with us! For instance, when emotionally down, we may feel like quitting. When we are hurt, we may sense a strong pull to prove our innocence. If you allow emotions to rule you, it has the power to ruin your life.

Proverbs 29:11 says, "Foolish people lose their tempers, but wise people control theirs". So before moving on to the new venture, make sure you are driven by purpose, not pushed by emotions.

#### 2. Am I wired to do this?

**One of the wonderful things about God is that He has created each one of us to do something special. He built in us desires and skills to accomplish that work.**

For instance, a nurse has an in-built attitude of caring while a carpenter has an in-built attitude of creativity. You possess a unique set of abilities and personality. So before launching into something new, make sure you are wired to undertake it.

1 Peter 4:10 exhorts, "Each of you has received a gift to use to serve others. Be good servants of God's various gifts of grace".

#### 3. Does my work history go with this?

Since God has wired us for a specific purpose, we will have an indelible mark of that purpose all through our work history. You may have changed jobs. You may have been in different work situations. But directly or indirectly, your life's divine purpose has emerged often in all these.

For instance, Moses was destined to be a deliverer. But for many years, it seemed like that wasn't his vocation. However, the truth is, his life's purpose emerged at different situations – whether it was his own miraculous deliverance from death as a baby or rescuing a fellow Jew from his oppressor or rescuing Reuel's daughters from the shepherds or tending his father-in-law's sheep.

**Evaluate your work history to see glimpses of your divine purpose. Then evaluate your new venture to see the same glimpse.**

#### 4. What does my spouse and close friends say about this?

When sensing the urge to launch out into the uncharted terrain, it is quite natural that most of the entrepreneurial kind of folks feel to do this in a hurry since they are overwhelmed with excitement. However there is great benefit in calming down and consulting with your spouse and close friends about your new venture.

The Scripture says in Proverbs 11:14, "Where no counsel is, the people fall; but in the multitude of counsellors there is safety". More than any other, it's your spouse who knows you – your strengths, your weaknesses, your likes, your nature and many other. Your close friends also know you better than those in the outer circle. An open consultation with your spouse and close friends help you get a better picture about the feasibility of your new venture.

#### 5. Have I counted the cost?

**Every endeavour has got a price tag. Each task has different price tags on it. Nothing evolves without a price. This is especially true for a worthwhile task.**

It is easy to jump in. But only those who pay the price can keep swimming upstream! Check out what Jesus said about this: "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'" (Luke 14:28-30)

Cost is not always monetary. It can also mean time, willingness, ability and resources. Make sure you are committed to pay the price, whatever that be.

What is the problem? Where is my wife and my child? Talk to me doctor! He screamed at the doctor. Calm down sir! How do you expect me to calm down when my wife is in there for the past two days? Calm down my son, his mother said to him. What is the problem? Okay, if you want me to address you here, no problem sir, the doctor said adjusting his glass, sir as you all know that we doctors only care, but God heals.. Meaning? David said as he moved closer to the doctor. We tried our best on your wife, but am sorry to tell you we lost her. I don't get you doctor? Your wife and the baby are dead, the doctor said sadly. Nooooooooooooo! David screamed

It a lie! Esther can't be dead! That's not true! David screamed as he rushed to Esther's bed in the hospital. Esther wake up, please let's go home, you promised to stay with me. You promised to grow old with me. You promised to love me forever, you promised me for better, for worst please stand up, David said as tears flowed freely from his eyes. Esther plsssss! The doctor and nurses dragged him away from Esther's corpse. He fought back... Leave me alone! Leave me! I want to talk to my wife, we came here together and we must leave together! He shouted as they dragged him away. Esther's mum on hearing the news of the death of her daughter fainted and her father cried like a baby, everybody was crying. It was a sad moment for everyone. David refused to go home, am staying with my wife, she is not dead, she is just asleep, and he told everyone. His parent had to drag him to their house, he couldn't sleep throughout the night. He couldn't sleep, all he could see was Esther's image, his parents and friends tried to help him move on, but he refused their help. Few weeks after David lost his wife, he left his parent's house and went home. The whole house speaks about Esther, the pictures on the wall, kitchen, bedroom, her clothes, the memories of Esther kept flashing back in his memory David picked one of the picture after another, looked at them and hugged them... He couldn't sleep in the bedroom that night, he slept in the living room holding Esther's pictures One faithful afternoon while he was at home, a friend of his named Fred from abroad came to visit him. David am sorry, I heard about your wife's death. 'I can't believe Esther is gone just like that. That is life David, you need to move on', Fred said. 'Humm... Move on? How can I move on with life without Esther? She was my mother, my sister, my life, she was everything to me, and life without her have been so terrible. Esther practically worshipped me. I really loved her Fred.' David wept 'I know, it okay, but you know Esther won't be happy seeing you this way either. Do you believe if she was alive she will be happy seeing you like this? You need to move on to make her happy wherever she is. You need to be strong.' Fred said patting him. 'Thank so much Fred, I have heard you. How is your family over there?' 


