FAITH CLINIC

Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; he will neither fail you nor abandon you.

I quote this verse far too often, to myself, but also to family and friends. Quoting is easy: confidently living out its content proves exceptionally challenging. When gazing back over my life, I see quite a lot of fear and discouragement. As a young Christian I met disappointment with frustration, often expressed in angry outbursts. I lacked a lot of self-control – yet it was one of the **fruit** of the Spirit I received upon choosing to follow Jesus. It cost me nothing. For so long, I failed to realise God's provision was already within my grasp. My problem was my failure, or unwillingness, to take hold of this fruit and apply it in managing any difficult set of circumstances.

I have spent much time wondering at my stupidity and inability to take hold of what was already mine in Christ and secure the benefits for a less tempestuous life.

I might have retained any number of relationships that disintegrated under the violence of my temper tantrums. Yet God has wonderfully forgiven me and enabled me to forgive myself. God reminds me I need not fear tomorrow, and he has already preceded me into my fears for tomorrow.

Even death has not only been tamed, but utterly destroyed by the risen saviour. Jesus endured its agonies that we might know it offers nothing more but the threshold beyond which lies eternity with Christ.

As Paul declares: "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?"

The challenge, this side of death, is to find and retain a confidence in God's complete provision for us, at all times.

INTRODUCTION: Today, we shall examine the last gift under the gift of speech or words.

This is the gift of prophecy.

LESSON IV. THE GIFTS OF SPEECH (OR WORDS)

c). THE MANIFESTATION OF PROPHECY

As manifested in the life of Jesus Christ. Matthew 23:37-39, Luke 13:34-35

As manifested in the life of Agabus. Acts 11:28-30, 21:10-16

As manifested in the Old Testament. II Kings 7:1-20

1. DEFINITION OF MANIFESTATION OF PROPHECY

- a. It is the speaking forth of the mind and counsel of God. A message that is initiated by the Holy Spirit and is received by the individual through revelation. The individual does not meditate, as the message is given spontaneously and will be unrehearsed. This will be found in the word of God, that is, it will be Biblical.
- b. **NOTE:** Our known language will become the means by which the Holy Spirit will communicate a specific message to the congregation to meet a specific situation. The manifestation is a means by which God is able to speak directly to His people.

2. THE PURPOSE OF PROPHECY

- a. The purpose of the manifestation of prophecy is directly related to the believers and it is three - fold (I Cor. 14:3):
 - i. To edify or build up
 - ii. To comfort or cheer up
 - iii. To exhort or stir up
- b. **POINT:** This gift can be manifested through both male and female members of the congregation. Joel 2:28, Acts 2:14-18

3. THE OPERATION OF PROPHECY

- a. The manifestation of prophecy will always be delivered in the form of a message.
- b. The message will be extremely short in duration. Not more than a few minutes or moments.
- c. As noted above, the message is received by revelation as the Holy Spirit reveals the message through individuals who possess the gift
- d. It does not come through the study of the scriptures.
 - i. However, the Holy Spirit will often use our knowledge of the word.
 - ii. The word of God is the source which God's Spirit draws upon to bring forth a short and concise message to the congregation.
- e. There will be no attempt to interpret the message, as all forms of prophecy will always be in the language of the people.
- f. This gift will not be directed at individuals in the assembly, but will be directed to the entire congregation.
- g. This gift is different from the ministry of the Prophet and service gift of prophecy in Romans 12 (not all who prophesies are prophet). This prophecy most times starts with Thus says the Lord while that of service gift has nothing to do with it. This gift manifests in the life of the Prophet by ministry.

If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.



The Jesus that I want would probably listen to my music, look like my race, match my Myers Briggs, and fight for my ideology.



The Jesus that I want would probably die for people who liked me or were like me or were most likely.



PROCLAIMING THE GOOD NEWS

The Bible clearly tells believers to proclaim the gospel to all people. Yet, while we certainly want others to know Jesus, many of us become paralyzed at the thought of engaging in spiritual conversations. If that describes you, take heart—you're in good company.

Some of God's spokesmen were horrified at the thought of speaking to others about the Lord. Begging to be excused from his speaking assignment, Moses told God, "I have never been eloquent, neither recently nor in time past" (Ex. 4:10).

And centuries later Jeremiah reacted to a similar mission by saying, "I do not know how to speak because I am a youth" (Jer. 1:6).

Then in the New Testament, Paul's first letter to the Corinthians says that he came "in weakness and in fear and in much trembling" to share the message with them (1 Corinthians 2:3).

The apostle wasn't tongue-tied, however; he knew well how to persuade with logic. Instead, Paul was afraid he might resort to human arguments, though his goal was to speak "not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit" (1 Corinthians 2:13).

Many believers have fears about sharing the gospel, but Jesus calls us to "go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation" (Mark 16:15).

So lean on the Spirit, who gives us the mind of Christ. Then, no matter the obstacles, you will be able to proclaim the Saviour's love.

OVERCOMERS

Concerning our salvation, God was seemingly faced with a very difficult problem. God loves us and He wants to save us. But He must save us in a way that satisfies Him and satisfies His righteousness.

There are four factors in this "problem" which God faced:

We have sinned.

We, therefore, should be punished. God loves us and wants to save us. God cannot be unrighteous.

How did God solve this "problem"? He solved it by sending His Son to take our place and die for our sins. Both the Father and the Son agreed with this. Jesus said, *"Therefore does My Father love Me, because I lay down My life..."* (John 10:17). The following story illustrates this:

Suppose that I am the principal of a school, and I make a rule that there is to be no cursing. I write the rule on the chalkboard, and the whole school sees and hears it. I say also that there is to be a punishment if anyone breaks the rule.

In the school there is a boy named Jimmy, whom I love very much, but Jimmy gets into a lot of trouble. I have had to punish him several times. At recess Jimmy curses. Everybody hears him, and I hear him also. Everyone knows that I hear him.

When recess is over, all the children come into the auditorium. All the students are looking at me to see what I will do. I have a son of my own in the room. John is my only son, and I love him dearly. I ask John to step out in the hall with me.

I say, *"Son, Jimmy has broken my rule. There must be a punishment. I must keep my word. Jimmy thinks that I hate him because he broke my rule, but you know that I love him. I want to ask you, 'Will you take Jimmy's punishment for him?'"*

My son says, *"Yes, Father, I will do anything for you that you wish. And I love Jimmy too."*



I say, *"Jimmy has broken my rule against cursing. You know that I said that there is to be a punishment if anyone breaks my rule. 'I must keep my word. But my son John says that he will take Jimmy's punishment. He says that he will do this gladly for me and for Jimmy.'"*

Then I punish my son. I punish him just as if he had broken the rule himself. When the punishment is over, I say, *"Jimmy, I want you to know that I love you and I have nothing against you—nothing at all. I want you to come forward now and give me your hand."*

Jimmy comes forward in tears. He takes my hand and says, *"I did not know that you loved me that much!"*

TURN BACK TO GOD

Give Me Childlike Simplicity and Purity of Faith

Practicing virtue without humility is like carrying dust against wind.

In the Gospel according to St. Mathew 11:25-27, Jesus thanks the Father in heaven for revealing to his disciples the wisdom and knowledge of God. Jesus' prayer tells us that God is both Father and Lord of earth as well as heaven. He is both Creator and Author of all that he has made, the first origin of everything and transcendent authority, and at the same time, goodness and loving care for all his children.

Jesus' prayer also contains a warning that pride can keep us away from the love and knowledge of God. Pride is the inordinate love of oneself at the expense of others and the exaggerated estimation of one's own learning and importance. Intellectual pride, coldness of heart, and stubbornness of will shut out God and his kingdom. **Pride is the root of all vice and the strongest influence propelling us to sin.**

It first vanquishes the heart, making it cold and indifferent towards God. It also closes the mind to God's truth and wisdom for our lives.

Jesus contrasts intellectual pride with child-like simplicity and humility. The simple of heart are like "little children" in the sense that they see purely without pretence and acknowledge their dependence and trust in the one who is greater, wiser, and more trustworthy. They seek one thing — the "summum bonum" or "greatest good" who is God himself. Simplicity of heart is wedded with humility, the queen of virtues, because humility inclines the heart towards grace and truth.

Just as pride is the root of every sin and evil, so **humility is the only soil in which the grace of God can take root.** It alone takes the right attitude before God and allows him as God to do all. God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble (Proverbs 3:34; James 4:6). **Only the humble in heart can receive true wisdom and understanding of God and his ways.** We can have no virtue without humility. Practising virtue without humility is like carrying dust against the wind. It will all blow away.

Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax-collector

We see it in the parable of the Pharisee and the tax-collector. The Pharisee did many good things: he fasted twice in a week; he gave one tenth of his income to the temple. But he ruined all these with his pride. The Tax-collector did many evil things. But he was forgiven for all these and made right with God because of his humble prayer.

In this prayer, Jesus makes a claim which no one would have dared to make: He is the perfect revelation of God. One of the greatest truths of the Christian faith is that we can know the living God. Our knowledge of God is not simply limited to knowing something about God, but we can know God personally.

In Jesus we see the perfect love of God

The essence of Christianity, and what makes it distinct from Judaism and other religions, is the knowledge of God as our Father. Jesus makes it possible for each of us personally to know God as our Father. To see Jesus is to see what God is like.

In Jesus we see the perfect love of God — a God who cares intensely and who yearns over men and women, loving them to the point of laying down his life for them upon the Cross. Jesus is the revelation of God — a God who loves us completely, unconditionally and perfectly. Jesus also promises that God the Father will hear our prayers when we pray in his name. That is why Jesus taught his followers to pray with confidence, Our Father who art in heaven..... Give us this day our daily bread. Do we pray to our Father in heaven with joy and confidence in his love and care for us?

Today, Jesus invites us to learn humility from him. He says: "Learn of me for I am meek and humble of heart." It is especially from his Passion that we learn humility. Scourged at the pillar, crowned with thorns, mocked, spat upon, and finally nailed to the cross, he died on that infamous gallows. It was to cure us of our pride. How can we look at Jesus crucified and still be proud?

Let us often look at the Crucifix and say: "Jesus meek and humble of heart, give me the child-like simplicity and purity of faith to gaze upon your face with joy and confidence in your all-merciful love. Remove every doubt, fear, and proud thought which would hinder me from receiving your word with trust and humble submission."

SECRET OF A WOMAN.

At one time, a newly married young man was shouting at his 20 years old wife and his father called him aside and said to him, 'We only shout at people our shouts or threats can frighten. But not to your wife.'

The way you are shouting, you are giving away your power to your wife. Your threats make her stronger. Most men believe that when a woman is threatened, she gets subdued, but women are not changed with fear.

A woman may stay quiet when a man is threatening and shouting at her but she is not sitting down inside her. She is evaluating the man's weakness and how to subdue him rather.

Cast your mind back to those days men used to beat their wives flippantly at slightest provocations, today most of those men are older and they suffering consequences. Those women their husband were beating years back are the ones enjoying the marriage with their children today, the mothers have their children's sympathy, the men are at the receiving end.

Let it become clear to men that the way into a woman's heart is not to try to threaten and subdue her. God spoke to men and said, 'Husbands, love your wife'. Do you need an elaborate explanation of this scripture? Love makes women weak. When you truly love a woman and show it, she will submit to you without qualms. But when a woman has sensed that she is just like your toy, you just want to use her or you are domineering and controlling, the spirit of rebellion takes over her. She might not physically stand on your way but she is plotting coup against you and one day, you will sit and watch her and her children force you to follow their rules or die quicker.

Almost all the great and fierce kings you know died before their wives. They lived all through their lives threatening their fellow men and wives. They were able to kill most of their strong fellow men but all the women they threatened stayed alive. Women know how to survive against men.

The 'lion' in men does not scare women or get them to submit to you, it is love that conquers a woman, not force or threats. This might subdue fellow men, but not your wife. Women naturally know how to survive pains. They can walk to the fearful serpent and make their demands. They have resilient spirit.

There are things women fear but not the lion inside men. They can submit and respect their men so foolishly that you imagine that there is no gut inside them. They have guts men don't have, love your woman into submission.

Men don't have compatible or cordial relationship with women by showing the lion inside them. God knew women before us and begged that we show love than threats. He gave men the formula, recipe for a blissful, joyous and fulfilled homes, LOVE YOUR WIFE!

This formula of loving your wife will help you win her. When a woman is loved, you break all her guts and she stays in your hands.

Not Taking Advantage

Don't harm yourself! We are all here! Acts 16:28

Several inmates were collecting roadside garbage to reduce their jail time when their supervisor, James, collapsed. They rushed to his aid and realized he was having a medical emergency. One inmate borrowed James' phone to call for help.

The sheriff's department later thanked the inmates for helping get their supervisor prompt medical attention, especially because they could have instead neglected him—to his great detriment as he was having a stroke—or used the situation to their own advantage to escape.

The kindness of the inmates' actions is not unlike those of Paul and Silas when they were imprisoned. After they'd been stripped, beaten, and thrown into prison, an earthquake struck so violently that it loosed their chains and shook the prison doors off their hinges (Acts 16:23-26).

When the jailer awoke, he naturally assumed the prisoners had fled, so he prepared to take his own life (to pre-empt what would've been his punishment for their escape). When Paul shouted, "We are all here!" (v. 28) the jailer was so moved by their actions—uncharacteristic of prisoners—that he became curious about the God they worshiped, ultimately coming to believe in Him too (vv. 29-34).
