
**PSALM 5:** For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous. With favour you will surround him as with a shield.

# **SUNDAY SCHOOL** THE MANIFESTATION GIFTS IX

**TEXT:** Acts 9:17-21

**MEMORY VERSE:** "When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water: and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him." Matthew 3:16 NKJV

**INTRODUCTION:** We explained the operation of the speaking in tongues in the last lesson. Today, we shall discuss the evidence of speaking in tongues.

## **LESSON IV. THE GIFTS OF SPEECH (OR WORDS)**

### **a) THE MANIFESTATIONS OF DIVERS OF TONGUES**

#### **iv. EVIDENCE OF SPEAKING IN TONGUES**

Speaking in tongues could be:

1. Evidence of baptism with the Holy Spirit, the same as having the Holy Spirit.
2. Evidence of being filled with the Holy Spirit Acts 10:44-46.
3. Evidence of anointing. Acts 2:3
4. Evidence of manifestation gift of divers of tongues. I Cor. 12:10.

**NOTE:** There is no place it was taught in the Scriptures that speaking in tongues is compulsory evidence of the baptism with the Holy Spirit. Let us look at some examples where people were baptized with the Holy Spirit and they did not speak in tongues.

5. Examples of baptism with the Holy Spirit without speaking in tongues:

- Jesus Christ did not speak with tongues. The Holy Spirit descended as a dove upon Him. Matthew 3:16
- The 3,000, 5,000 and the multitudes in Acts 2:41, 4:4 and 8:15-17 did not speak with tongues the day they believed.
- Paul did not speak in tongues when Ananias laid hands on him to be filled with the Holy Spirit, but the evidence of the Holy Spirit fullness was seen at that time (Acts 9:17-21). Later, Paul manifested the gift of tongues and He said, "I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than you all (I Corinthians 14:18), he spoke in tongues more than all the Corinthians.

### **CLASS DISCUSSION**

1. When one speaks in tongues, what does it denotes?
2. Is it compulsory to speak in tongues when one receives the Holy Spirit? If yes, give a scriptural passage to show where it was mandated.
3. If no, give examples where people received the Holy Spirit and did not speak in tongues and the evidence that was shown that they truly received the Holy Spirit.

**CONCLUSION:** We can now see that it is not compulsory to speak in tongues when baptized with Holy Spirit, but when you did not speak in tongues, the evidence will always be fullness (being filled) with the Holy Spirit. However, this is not to forbid people to speak in tongues (I Cor. 14:39).




### Setting Goals to Achieve God's Plan

God has a purpose for our life, but we need goals to help us stay on track ([Eph. 2:10](#)). In Genesis 24, Abraham's trusted servant demonstrated this well. He knew his goal, kept confidence, made a plan, and set a timeline. We should follow his example.

Once we know the direction God wants us to take, we must:

- Have a picture of the goal. A defined mission helps us weigh the opportunities God presents.
- Be confident that we can succeed through Christ. We are to look at the future in light of God's presence within us, His inexhaustible resources, and His promises ([Phil. 4:19](#); [2 Corinthians 1:20](#)).
- Desire to accomplish God's plan. His sacrificial, unending love motivates us to stay on the path He has set for us ([1 John 4:9-11](#)).
- Set a course of action. Try breaking a large goal into smaller tasks, and cover each step with prayer that earnestly seeks instruction from God.
- Set a timeline. Deadlines help propel us forward, and they can be adjusted as circumstances change.

Are you moving step-by-step toward God's purpose for you? If you're unsure what that looks like, ask for divine wisdom and guidance.

Do you sometimes daydream about what it would be like to be incredibly wealthy? When I do, I am self-centred, solving the financial woes of my family and friends, but with little thought for the real needs beyond. In a materialistic society where value is based on wealth, it's likely that your daydream wanders in this same direction.

I wonder how often you have meditated on the extravagant love you enjoy as a child of God. This blessing far exceeds any human ability to count and quantify anything material. It is, as St Paul recounts, beyond comprehension. We enjoy "every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms" (NLT). This is a realm we can only ever imagine. To my shame, I'm more in touch with my aggravations and annoyances than my evident blessings. I too often live my life in the light of my discomfort, rather than my joy.

This then raises a critical question for me about the extent to which I'm consciously "united with Christ" (NLT). It's not within my natural daily life budget to contemplate my many blessings. I must acknowledge that I give far greater weight to my mundane daily routine than to considering God's presence and provision. I have to pause and think before I can count my blessings.

The great news is that God's blessings are boundless and all available to me and to you. Our challenge is to begin to learn to live the God side of blessing. We are invited to change perspective and discover that every day is filled with sunshine.

I declare a shift to your season of set back. God will turn it around for you. It's your time of set-up for victory and elevation.

God will contend with everyone who contends against you. The battle is not yours. Give it over to God. He'll intervene on your behalf.

so He sent His Son into the world that we might know what He is really like. The Bible says, "No man has seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him [shown us what He is like]" (John 1:18).

Jesus taught us and showed us that God loves sinners. He loves us so much that He does not want to lose us forever. The Bible says that God "is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance [turn to God]" (2 Peter 3:9).

### What is God like?

**He is like Jesus!** The Lord Jesus said, "He that has seen Me has seen the Father." This is a most wonderful thing. The eternal, invisible God has been here on this earth. There is no need to wonder what God is like, for He has revealed Himself to us in His Son.

The Bible says, "God was manifest in the flesh..." (1 Timothy 3:16).

Jesus was anointed by God as the promised Saviour. Of all the people who have ever lived, one Man was anointed by God as "**the Christ**"—the promised Saviour. That Man is Jesus! The Bible says, "...God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with Him" (Acts 10:38).



It took place when Jesus was baptized. When Jesus came up out of the water, the heavens were opened, and the Spirit of God in the form of a dove came down and lighted upon Him. A voice came from the Father in Heaven saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17).

Out of the billions of people in all of humanity, you can point to Jesus and say without a doubt, "This is He—the Christ, the One anointed by God. This is the promised Saviour! This is the One who is both God and man."

## TURN BACK TO GOD

### Jesus Refuses To Heal, Thrice (Part 1)



Jesus often resists to grant the several prayers petitioned to Him. He does not give away, just like that for free. He often refuses. He may humiliate. He may intimidate. He may discriminate. He often tests. He may grant you your dark hour.

In Matthew 15:21-28 we read the three rounds of denials before a miracle is delivered to the daughter of the Canaanite woman, pursuant to the intercessory trial of her biological mother – the Canaanite woman. The dark hour of the Canaanite woman with Jesus.

**Jesus is not always easy to go with, if one takes on Him. He tests faith, before he delivers the Glory of God.**

"Kingdom of God, is for the determined. You need the strength and tactic of an unreserved-passenger getting into an overcrowded State Transport bus".

You have to use the strength of your determination, to overcome the hurdles of tests and faith to qualify for an explicit miracle from Jesus.

With His Grace, strategy of competing in the test of faith will produce profitable results. Jesus has responded with silence, taken more time, allowing some deliberate delays and presented some unusual excuses before he granted miracles for several of the prayers.

We try to discern, a sample of the process practiced by Jesus in delivering a miracle, granting a prayer, in enacting the drama of salvation to the daughter of the Canaanite woman.

#### Jesus denies to cure, The First time

The Canaanite mother is praying to Jesus to save her demon-possessed daughter.

First, I observe the presence of a relationship between the intercessor and the affected – a mother and daughter relationship. She then prays to Jesus as an intercessor on behalf of her daughter. And Matthew 15: 23 records, Jesus did not answer a word in response to her prayer.

By not answering, Jesus denied her the first time. Or by silence he discounted the prayer value down to zero. Often silence is His communication style, before a miracle.

**A prayer being un-answered is thus the labour pain preceding the birth of a miracle.** I see this silence when the sisters Martha and Mary prayed for the healing of their dying brother Lazarus.

In several places Jesus is a "silent God", a "blind God", a "deaf God", a "sleeping God" until we burn our faith offering in good volumes, until we breath out enough faith, until we build the bridge of faith to an adequate length, until we climb high enough on the graph of faith, establishing a live Holy Spirit connection between our prayer and His miracle.

Let us examine how the Canaanite mother laboured her pain to give birth to a miracle for her demon-possessed daughter.

# READERS' DIGEST. George Floyd, the Black Race, and the Greatest Love of All

**PLEASE READ THIS ARTICLE FROM RENO OMOKIRI. HE IS A PASTOR TOO.**

God created diversity. It is Satan that created racism. How do I know? The first time racism occurred in Scripture ("Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married"-Numbers 12:1), God punished the racists.

Many people have asked why I am yet to comment on the George Floyd case, and the truth is that I am not as concerned about Blue on Black killings as I am about Black on Black killings. For every Black man killed by a White cop, there are over 20 Black people murdered by their fellow Blacks. The death of George Floyd is a tragedy. Officer Chauvin AND HIS CREW must be charged as a lesson. But the Black race must learn our own lesson. Protests are good. But destroying infrastructure in Black neighbourhoods doesn't help George get justice!

Many Africans who have never travelled out of Africa are sadly unaware of the tragedy of Black disunity. They are shocked when they first get to London or New York and expect the Blacks they meet there to embrace them, only to be scorned! When I first became a resident in America at age 9, the only people who ever called me 'African booty scratcher' or who told me to go back to Africa were my fellow Blacks. I lived in Albany, California, which was very White in the 80s. Not once did I experience that from Whites!

We Black people have to start loving ourselves. Then and only then will we be valued. To a large extent, we don't love or even like ourselves. If a Black African goes to Europe or America, too often, it is Whites in those countries who are friendlier to him than his or her fellow Blacks.

I remember when I first went to school in England, I was stuck in the underground. Naturally, I was drawn to asking other Blacks like me. Not one of my fellow Blacks even listened to me. The first White man I asked entered the tube with me and took me to my school.

Look at the knife crimes in London. Who is killing who? Look at the murders in Chicago. Who is killing who? Even look at the abortion rate per race. Who is killing their unborn children? These are uncomfortable conversations Blacks should have. Right there in America, many East Coast Blacks don't like West Coast Blacks. And many Blacks on both American coasts don't like African Blacks. Caribbean Blacks don't like African Blacks. How then can we expect others to like us if we don't like ourselves?

We cannot behave as if #Black Lives Matter only when a White person does the killing. If Black lives matter, it should matter above board. It should matter when Blacks kill Blacks and when Blacks hate Blacks and when Blacks discriminate against Blacks.

We Blacks are very reactionary to racism, and we should reject it. But do we love ourselves? In South Africa, did we love ourselves? How many Black people died at the hands of fellow Blacks in SA? We must reject racism amongst ourselves first.

In Africa, many of our well-known comedians have made tasteless jokes about dark-skinned Blacks like Lupita Nyong'o. In America, Blacks sororities and fraternities reject fellow Blacks if they can't pass The Brown Paper Bag Test. Simone Biles became the most decorated American gymnast. While the world was celebrating her, we Blacks were denigrating her (Google it) for refusing to 'fix' her hair (chemically straighten it to make it less nappy). We have our issues.

In Nigeria, we have a President who favours his own Fulani tribe above other Nigerians. A man who killed 347 Shiite men, women, children and infants. What the White police did to George Floyd is not up to what General Buhari is doing to Nigerians. If a White President says 'constituents that gave me 97% cannot be treated same with constituencies that gave me 5%' and then goes on to exclude Blacks, there would be an uproar. But it is happening in Nigeria. And we accept it!

Recently, some young persons have been killed by the police in Nigeria. Ditto for Kenya and South Africa. Where was this George Floyd level rage? Or is it okay for Black police officers to kill Blacks and not okay for White police? Isn't that racist?

In Nigeria, a Governor's son (Nasir El-Rufai), labelled a whole ethnic group and called an Igbo mother a bed jumper that he would pass around to his friends. Tuh went the sound. Many of those raging over George Floyd defended him. A significant challenge with the Black Race is that every Black person wants to be Black when a White person kills or is racist to another Black person. But few of us are Black enough to be Black when a Black person kills or is racist/tribalistic to another Black. Right now, there is an episodic massacre ongoing in Southern Kaduna. Black herdsmen are killing Black pastoralists. If I put up the pictures on social media, Twitter and Facebook may ban my account. We should care about George Floyd. We should also care about Southern Kaduna.

In Southern Kaduna, you see the frontlines of Nigeria's ethnic and religious divide. A young man, Bello Shagari, put up a tweet saying (inaccurately) that the Southern Kaduna Massacre is a hoax because someone told him. I responded by listing 3 Northern Muslim journalists who confirmed that the massacre is real. It has not escaped my notice that Bello is of the same ethnicity of those suspected of being the perpetrator of the killings.

And we want to settle the George Floyd matter when we have not settled our genocidal hatred of each other.

We do not like ourselves, and we expect others to like us, and when they don't, we shout racism. Have we forgotten Whitney Houston's song, The Greatest Love of All (originally by George Benson)?

Is easy to achieve

Let us be truthful to ourselves. The Black Race has not yet found this Greatest Love of All. The Jews have found it. The Arabs exude it. Caucasians have it. The Asiatic races have it. Latin America has it to an extent. However, we, the Black people, do not yet have this love.

And until we do, we will never truly fulfil our potential. We will keep on investing in arms to kill ourselves when we should be developing farms to feed ourselves. The worst is that we do not even take responsibility. It is the White man's fault. It is the Arab. It is our climate. It is... No. It is our fault. And it is our duty to find a solution! And until we find a solution, there will be many more George Floyds in America and many more Southern Kaduna Massacres. If it were not so sad, I would have found it amusing that those Nigerians who are rightly calling for the trial of the cop responsible for killing George Floyd are not angry that Buratai, who masterminded the killings of 347 Shiite men, women, children and infants, was not punished for his crimes. Rather, he was promoted by General Buhari to Lieutenant General.

I urge Nigerians and other Africans to do locally what they expect others to do globally. Only then will we have the moral authority to condemn incidences like George Floyd's killing.




