

SUNDAY SCHOOL

THE MINISTERIAL GIFTS VI

Text: Ephesians 4:11-15

MEMORY VERSE: "Whom will he teach knowledge? And whom will he make to understand the message? Those just weaned from milk? Those just drawn from the breasts?" Isaiah 28:9 NKJV

INTRODUCTION: A divine principle is a truth which will work and apply in any given situation. It never changes. Therefore, it is the ground upon which we can build our personal lives as Christians, that is why we have Teachers by ministry in the New Testament to give the divine principles. Today, we shall conclude discussion on teaching ministry, revise and summarise the ministerial gifts.

LESSON

EXPLANATION ON EACH OF THE MINISTERIAL GIFT TEACHER (INSIDE)

1. Importance of a Teacher

- a. He meets the teaching of error with truth and doctrine to expose heresy and false teachings (doctrines).
- b. He protects the saints from being tossed to and fro with every wind of doctrines.
- c. He matures (perfect) the church with the truth of the Word of God.

2. The Teacher's Preparation

- a. He reads (both the scriptures and books) extensively to gain knowledge
- b. He knows both the Old and New Testaments thoroughly.
- c. His primary concern is to teach all the major doctrines of the Bible. (Though, some Teachers are more practically oriented.
- d. He prays and meditates continually (sometimes or years) to gain Holy Spirit understanding on each doctrine he teaches.
- e. He seeks for doctrinal facts, knowledge and understanding to interpret the scriptures correctly.

Differences between Teaching and other Ministries.

- The Prophet has messages, but Teacher has doctrines.
- Pastor has the people before him, Teacher has the Word before him.
- Teacher set forth the truth, while the Pastor endeavoured to see how the truth is being received individually.

POINT: Teachers often minister with Prophets as a team. Teachers establish doctrinal foundations while Prophets apply the word, encourage and motivate to do the word and will of God.

a. Jesus Christ, The Master Teacher

- i. In many places in the Scripture, Jesus Christ is called "Master" or "Teacher." John 3:2,
- ii. His teaching ministry is unique because He taught with power and authority by the anointing of the Holy Spirit. His words were "spirit and life" - giving, because He spoke only that which He had received from His Father. John 6:63, 7:16, 8:28.
- iii. As a master Teacher Jesus Christ relied on the words of His Father and the Holy Spirit. That was the key to the success of His earthly ministry.
- iv.

SUMMARY AND REVISION OF THE FIVE-FOLD MINISTRIES

1. The Apostle's chief concern is to reaching the people where the gospel has not gone before, leading them to Jesus Christ and establishing them into functioning Churches. He guides missions.
2. The Prophet's desire is to apply the scriptures so that the saints can walk righteously before God. He guides God's righteousness.
3. The Evangelists chief concern is for the lost, that they may be born again. He guides the grace of God.
4. The Shepherd's strength is the love of God demonstrated to the saints. He guides the love of God.
5. The Teacher's chief concern is to interpret the truth of the Word of God. He guides the truth of God and His Word.

CLASS DISCUSSION

1. Give reasons why Teacher is important.
2. Talk briefly about Teacher's preparation.
3. Differentiate between the Teaching ministry and other ministries.
4. What makes the teaching ministry of Jesus Christ unique?
5. Give general summary, revision and conclusion of the ministerial gifts and what each of them guides.

CONCLUSION: To have received a ministerial gift from the Lord Jesus Christ is to submit oneself as a servant for the sake of the church. These ministries do not make one the head over the congregation, but rather, the servant of all, Jesus Christ Himself is the only Head of the Church. All others are under His authority. All other ministries, with the exception of the Apostle, operate under the oversight function of the Elders of the Local Church.




I pray for you today that the God of restoration will restore all that the enemies have stolen from you speedily and permanently. In Jesus Mighty Name. Amen.





TRUE GREATNESS

Matthew 20:20-28

There is a great contrast between the world's value system and the Lord's. The danger for believers is that we can easily slip into the culture's way of thinking without realizing that our perspective is out of line with God's.



This is vividly illustrated in the request of James and John's mother. She wanted greatness and honour for her sons but sought it in a manner contrary to the Lord's ways, which caused discord among the disciples. Self-promotion isn't the way to esteem or harmony with others. Jesus' life illustrates the exact opposite. He didn't come to be served but to serve and give up His life to ransom lost sinners (Matt. 20:28).

As Christians, we are to emulate Jesus' submission to the Father and spirit of servanthood. Whether in ministry or secular employment, we must consider ourselves as servants and our work as being under the Lord's authority. This means we are to humble ourselves and submit to those who are in charge, valuing them and even overlooking bothersome character traits or habits—we are to serve them as if we were serving Christ Himself. We may never be applauded for our work here on earth but our reward is in heaven

Listen my Son, your antagonists will increase at every second of your progress. My entrepreneur father said some few years ago.

One day he said, walk with me, I have something to show you.

He went to the *mango tree* at the backyard, and requested I pluck a fruit from the tree. Actually the ripe one. I looked carefully and replied; dad, I can't see any ripe one here. He stared at me for few seconds, this time, my heartbeat increased. He had actually warned me to be prudent like King Solomon anytime I come close to him because the race is not for the ignorant anymore.

I adjusted my breath for another few seconds, I said again; dad, I can't find any ripe MANGO. Beautiful, he said, with a confident tone. Then he continued..... Nobody will know you when you are not ripped. Nobody will attack you when your glory isn't showing. At this stage, you are like the unripe fruit. Ignored and overlooked because your fruit is not nutritional.

Here is your first lesson Son, don't fight to be seen or noticed, rather work to get your fruit to be ripened.

It's the nature of man to ignore people who are not productive.

To be noticed, work more on your seed.

Come with me, this time, he took me to the coconut tree. Look around here and pluck two fruits for me. I looked critically at *the coconut tree,* it was tall and uneasy to get, so I carefully took a big stick and hit it from afar and it fell loudly to the ground. Then I gave the two fruits to him. Then he said, *Here is it Son, the more productive you become, the more enemies you attract just like the coconut tree.* It's the nature of man to come for you because you are ripe. They attack you just like you attack the coconut tree. *Don't be moved, it is your right to fulfil destiny no matter the attack on you.*

Keep growing. You are growing for two purposes. *One, as a shade for those that are helpless to hide and two, as a fruit for those that are hungry to eat from*. Understand this, your *COURSE* is beyond the attacker. Grow your lens of reasoning if you will last long as a fruitful tree.

You see that coconut tree, no matter how many you pluck, it won't dry up because of you. It will keep producing more coconut. It is because it produces more that makes it relevant in my compound. If not, I would have uprooted it a long time ago.

Just because your partner betrays your love doesn't stop you from loving someone else. You are productive, and you need to show your commitment as a tree that is fruitful, not as a tree that dries up, because of one person that plucks from it.

Just because someone defrauds you, is not enough reason not to trust. *Trust is part of what makes your tree productive. Keep trusting till it gets you to your breakthrough.*

Just because some people don't like what you do is not enough reason not to like yourself. *Be your first admirer. Treat yourself with so much love and respect*. Nature will command people to take the course of likeness on you.

See Son, look at that *bitter leaf* at the other side of the compound, go and taste it. I moved a bit and I said, dad, I don't really like it. He smiled and said, *this shows that, not everyone will like what you are, but you must never allow that to determine how you grow.*

That bitter leaf is never scared of growing no matter the hatred you have towards it because it knows, one day, you will come looking for it and it will be your only saviour at that time. You will give it all the attention you thought you couldn't give. Don't stop growing Son.

***When your enemies increase for no reason, pay attention, your success is taking another dimension they can't handle, the effect is dimensional*.**

The bitter leaf will attract enemies because of the kind of projection and growth it takes but sooner, it will be the ultimate search for many.

***You can be the ultimate search for someone tomorrow,* so *learn to improve your skills of growth today*.**

You are not growing to compete with the next person.

Coconut trees don't compete with the apple tree, their seasons of growth and cycle are different.

Learn to apply this in your journey in life.

Your competition is not with someone else. It is God who brought you on this journey and he knows when your fruit will ripe, so don't envy others when their fruit ripens.

***Seasons of growth is what matters. Move and grow at your own pace*.**



I am "in Christ"

My "position" in Christ

The Bible speaks of my "position" *in Christ* and my "walk" with Christ. I need to know the difference between my position and my walk.



What is my "position" *in Christ*? My position is the way God sees me. Before I was saved, I was in Adam's sinful family. God saw me as being in Adam. In Adam I was not acceptable to God.


The moment I took Christ as my Saviour, God took me out of Adam's sinful family and put me in His new family. I am no longer in Adam; I am now *in Christ*.

I now have a new position in God's sight. God now sees me *in Christ*. He loves me and accepts me in the same way that He loves and accepts His own beloved Son.

Can I lose my position *in Christ*?

No, I cannot. My position *in Christ* depends on who Christ is. Because Christ is perfect, God always sees me as perfect *in Christ*. When I sin, I lose the joy of fellowship with the Lord, but I never lose my position *in Christ*.

My "walk" with Christ.



My "walk" with Christ is the way I live, day by day. Because God loves me and accepts me fully and perfectly in Christ, I want to live in a way that honours Him. I represent the Lord Jesus Christ here in the world. Here are some verses that tell me how I should "walk" with Christ:

"That you might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing..." Colossians 1:10

"For you were sometimes darkness, but now are you light in the Lord: walk as children of light." Ephesians 5:8

"See then that you walk circumspectly [carefully], not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil." Ephesians 5:15-16

God always accepts me according to my position in Christ, and not according to my walk. This does not mean that I can be careless about my conduct. Sin causes me to lose the joy of my salvation.

When I realize that I have sinned, when should I confess that sin to God? I should confess that sin immediately! If my sin involved another person, I should ask their forgiveness. When I do this, God forgives me and restores my joy.

TURN BACK TO GOD

Get Rid Of Your Lustful Eyes



If we are to be holy, we should guard our eyes very carefully. This is taken from the reflection on Christ's words from the Sermon on the Mount: "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall not commit adultery.' But I say to you that everyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart" (Mt 5:27-28).

Pope John Paul II acknowledged that these are severe words. But he asked, are we to fear the severity of these words, or rather have confidence in their power to save us? These words have power to save us because the one who speaks them is the "Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" (Jn 1:29).

Lust obscures God's original plan

Most people see in Christ's words only a condemnation. Do we forget that Christ came into the world not to condemn, but to save? (Jn 3:17). Christ's words about lust call us back to the original truth of the body and sexuality.

As part of the heritage of original sin, **lust obscures in each of us God's original, beautiful plan for the body and sexual love** – but it hasn't snuffed it out. The heritage of our hearts is deeper than lust and the words of Christ reactivate that deeper heritage giving it real power in our lives

Imagine the human heart as a deep well. Starting from the top we have to pass through layers of muddy waters. But if we press through, at the bottom of the well we'll find a spring that, when activated, can gradually fill the well to overflow with pure, living water.

Lustful Look at the Human Body

If we think a "lustful look" is the only way a person can look at the human body, then we subscribe to "the interpretation of suspicion." Those who live by suspicion remain so locked in their own lusts that they project the same bondage on to everyone else. They can't imagine any way to think about the human body and the sexual relationship other than through the prism of lust.

When we hold the human heart in a state of irreversible suspicion because of lust, we condemn ourselves to a hopeless, loveless existence. As St. Paul warns us, we must avoid the trap of "holding the form of religion" while "denying the power of it" (2 Tim 3:5).

"Redemption is a truth, a reality, in the name of which man must feel called, and called with efficacy". In other words, the death and resurrection of Christ is effective. It can change our lives, our attitudes, our hearts. Yes – Christ's death and resurrection can change the way we experience sexual desire, away from lust and toward the truth of divine love.

The Interpretation of Suspicion

Much is at stake. As John Paul II stated, "*The meaning of life is the antithesis of the interpretation 'of suspicion.'*" This interpretation is very different, it is radically different from what we discover in Christ's words in the Sermon on the Mount." Christ's words about lust "reveal ...another vision of man's possibilities". Christ's words reveal the possibility of loving as God loves – not despite our sexuality but in and through it.

This demands "perseverance and consistency" in learning the meaning of our bodies, the meaning of our sexuality. We must learn this not only in the abstract (although this, too, is necessary), but above all in the interior reactions of our own "hearts."

Deep in the heart we learn to distinguish between what, on the one hand, composes the great riches of sexuality and sexual attraction, and what, on the other hand, bears only the sign of lust. And although these internal movements of the heart can sometimes be confused with one another, we have been called by Christ to acquire a mature and complete evaluation.

After 37 years of marriage. Jake dumped his wife for his Young secretary. His new girlfriend demanded that they live in Jake and Edith's multi-million dollar home and since the man's lawyers were a little better he prevailed.

He gave Edith his now ex-wife just 3 days to move out. She spent the 1st day packing her belongings into boxes crates and suitcases. On the 2nd day she had to movers come and collect her things. On the 3rd day she sat down for the last time at their beautiful dining room table by candlelight put on some soft background music and feasted on a pound of shrimp a jar of caviar and a bottle of Chardonnay.

When she had finished she went into each and every room and stuffed half-eaten shrimp shells dipped in caviar into the hollow of all of the curtain rods. She then cleaned up the kitchen and left. 6- I'm slowly learning that trying so hard to 'win' anyone is just a waste of time and energy and it fills you with nothing but emptiness.

7- I'm slowly learning that not reacting doesn't mean I'm okay with things, it just means I'm choosing to rise above it. I'm choosing to take the lesson it has served and learn from it.

8- I'm choosing to be the bigger person. I'm choosing my peace of mind because that's what I truly need. I don't need more drama. I don't need people making me feel like I'm not good enough. I don't need fights and arguments and fake connections.

9- I'm slowly learning that sometimes not saying anything at all says everything.

10- I'm slowly learning that reacting to things that upset you gives someone else power over your emotions

You can't control what others do but you can control how you respond, how you handle it, how you perceive it and how much of it you want to take personally.

11- I'm slowly learning that most of the time, these situations say nothing about you and a lot about the other person.

12- I'm slowly learning that maybe all these disappointments are just there to teach us how to love ourselves because that will be the Armor and the shield we need against the people who try to bring us down. Work on yourself and your inner peace and you'll come to realise that not reacting to every little thing that bothers you is the first ingredient to living a happy and healthy life._

LAST WORD

I've come to realise that there are only ever two directions available to me. Walking with God, or walking away from God. Being stationary isn't an option. Choosing salvation does not risk-proof us: we are subject to the anomalies of human existence in the same way as everyone else. However, in Christ, I can find the resolve and resilience to navigate my way through such anomalies. In doing so I may discover some wood that is reducing my fruitfulness. This I can easily surrender. Keeping it would reduce my fruitfulness as well as the fullness of joy which God gives me. More problematic, though, is walking away, a deliberate act of turning my back upon God. I have been tempted, and got close to this on some occasions. Yet, if God is to respect our free will, he must give us permission to walk away. Failure to do so would make him a dictator, benevolent perhaps, but still a tyrant. Finding God when in deep distress and/or pain is exceptionally difficult, but it's always the path that opens before us in times of trouble.


