
SUNDAY SCHOOL

THE PURPOSE OF CHURCH LEADERSHIP

Text: I Thessalonians 5:11-13, Hebrews 13:7:17

MEMORY VERSE: "Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken to you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation." Hebrews 13:7.

INTRODUCTION: In this section five, we shall briefly examine the church leadership and their primary purpose in the Church.



LESSON

1. WHO IS A LEADER AND CHURCH LEADER?

- a. A leader is a person who leads, guides, rules, directs or inspires others or a group of people.
- b. He is a person who influences a group of people towards the achievement of a goal.
- c. A leader by its meaning is the one who goes first and leads by example, so that others are motivated to follow him. To be a leader, a person must have a deep-rooted commitment to the goal that he will strive to achieve it even if nobody follows him. Example is Joshua. Numbers 27:11-23, Joshua 1:1-3, 24:15.
- d. There are natural, born and spiritual leaders.
- e. The Church Leaders are the people who are appointed, ordained or not but have the grace of God upon them to lead the Church as directed by the Holy Spirit.
 - i. There are four types of leader in the Church.
 1. They are leaders by age,
 2. gift,
 3. elders,
 4. Deacons and ministers.
 - a. We shall take them one by one and briefly examine them.



2. THE PRIMARY DUTY OF THE CHURCH LEADERS

- a. The proper objective of a congregation is not numerical growth alone but the development of spiritual strength.
- b. The primary duty of the leaders in the Local Church is to watch, observe, and sort out the gifts in each believer's life and set it in a proper place where they can relate with each other and grow to the edification of the whole body.
- c. The system whereby few people function, even not according to the gifts but by organization is not biblical.
 - i. The system where one ministry of Pastor is trying to perfect the church is not biblical.
 - ii. It cannot work and it is not according to God's design to perfect His Church.

3. THE CHURCH LEADERS


a. Leader by Service Gift. Rom 12:8

- i. "He who leads, with diligence."
- ii. Those who are gifted to effectively facilitate all areas of life. It can be among men, women, youth or any department in the Church to be their leader.
- iii. They are good organizers and managers.
- iv. Sometimes, they serve in a way most of the people who have this service gift did not notice.
- v. This type of leader in the church is not ordained, it is neither a title nor is it by appointment. It is for both male and female leadership.
- vi. This gift many times draws people because the possessors have foresight and could see ahead.
- vii. "With diligence - carefulness." Lead here means "standing before" or "to guide." By this meaning the gift, if not properly handled, has the tendency to stimulate pride in the possessor, hence, it has to be used with carefulness.





HIS PROMISE IN PERSECUTION

To get the most out of this devotion, set aside time to read the Scripture referenced throughout.

All around the world, intolerance and persecution of Christians is increasing. And even though we may face discrimination or judgment, the reality for many of us in the West is that we will never experience similar violence or oppression. Yet persecution has been a part of Christianity's story since its beginning. (See Acts 4-5.)

It's an uncomfortable thought but an important one. At some point or other, we may find ourselves grappling with whether persecution is worth it. In such moments, remember what Jesus promised: "Theirs is the kingdom of heaven" (Matt. 5:10). He wasn't being intentionally vague; He was talking specifically about us, His followers.

As Christians, we simply won't experience fullness of life if we're not willing to risk loving Him above all else—even if it costs us our job, our place in society, or our very life.

We are all selfish beings, and we all know it – whether or not we are believers. We know that, left to itself, our self-centred nature is destructive, but we don't agree on how to stop this happening. Is natural selection the inbuilt means to manage a self-perpetuating society, or does a personal God lie behind the many layers and textures that make up human existence and personal interaction?

Despite the advances of scientific enquiry, the question of where everything comes from remains. God, of course, is quite content to leave it to each of us to make up our mind. We have the unenviable task of deciding who God is, if indeed God is anything, or anyone, at all. The consequences could not be greater, for the ultimate end of our mortal existence lies within the choice we make. Jesus' manifestation isn't limited to the incarnation 2,000 years ago. God is present now and you're invited to meet with the reality of him in your daily experiences.

READERS' DIGEST

WILLIAM TYNDALE, the man who translated the Bible into English and was burnt alive at the ridiculous young age of 42 years old, for his efforts. (Google Foxe's book of Martyrs.)

Nearly 500 years ago, this week, William Tyndale, fondly called 'Father of the English Bible' was strangled and burned at the stake after being tried and convicted of heresy and reason for translating the Bible into English.

HIS OFFENSE! He translated the Greek Bible into English. That you have a Bible in a language you can read is largely due to his labours, and many of the very phrases you read in it retain the flavour of his understanding of the Greek and Hebrew.

A graduate of Oxford and Cambridge, Tyndale had a powerful desire to make the Bible available even to the common people in England, in order to correct the 'Biblical ignorance of the priests.' At one point Tyndale told a priest, "If God spares my life, are many years pass, I will cause a boy that driveth the plow, shall know more of the Scriptures than thou dost."

Today, 90% of the King James Version of the Holy Bible and 75% of the Revised Standard Version are from the translation made by Tyndale, a man to whom you owe more than you'll ever know. A nice dream, but how was Tyndale to accomplish his task, when translating the Bible into English was **ILLEGAL** at the time?'

He went to London to ask Bishop Tunstall if he could be authorised to make an English translation of the Bible, but the Bishop would not grant his approval. However, Tyndale would not let the disapproval of men stop him from carrying out what seemed so obviously God's will. With encouragement and support of some British merchants, he decided to go to Europe to complete his translation, then have it printed and smuggled back into England.

In 1524 Tyndale sailed for Germany. In Hamburg, he worked on the New Testament, and in Cologne, he found a printer who would print the work. However, news of Tyndale's activity came to an opponent of the Reformation who had the press raided.

Tyndale himself managed to escape with the pages already printed and made his way to the German city Worms where the New Testament was soon published. Six thousand copies were printed and smuggled into England.

The Bishops did everything they could to eradicate the Bibles. Bishop Tunstall had copies ceremoniously burned at St. Paul's; the Archbishop of Canterbury bought up copies to destroy them. Tyndale used the money to print improved editions! Tyndale continued hiding among the merchants in Antwerp and began translating the Old Testament while the King's agents searched all over England and Europe for him.

A copy of Tyndale's "The Obedience of a Christian Man" fell into the hands of Henry VIII, providing the king with the rationale to break the Church in England from the Roman Catholic Church in 1534.

In 1535, Tyndale was arrested and jailed in the castle of Vilvoorde (Filford) outside Brussels for over a year.

Tyndale's work was denounced by authorities of the Roman Catholic Church and Tyndale himself was accused of heresy.

Tyndale, 42 was finally found by an Englishman who pretended to be his friend but then turned him over to the authorities. After a year and a half in prison, he was brought to trial for heresy -- **FOR BELIEVING, among other things, IN THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS and that THE MERCY OFFERED IN THE GOSPEL WAS ENOUGH FOR SALVATION.** In August 1536, he was condemned and was executed [burned alive at the stake] publicly on October 6, 1536, in a small town in Belgium.

As he burnt to death, Tyndale reportedly said "Lord, open the king of England's eyes."

WAS HIS PRAYER ANSWERED? YES! The prayer was answered first in part when three years later, in 1539, Henry VIII required every parish church in England to make a copy of the English Bible available to its parishioners. Today, Tyndale's prayer is fully answered, not only are the King's eyes opened, but the Bible a universal instrument.

* In 1611, the 54 scholars who produced the King James Bible drew significantly from Tyndale, as well as from translations that descended from his.

* In 2002, Tyndale was placed at number 26 in the BBC's poll of the 100 Greatest Britons; but in heaven he surely would be before the preceding 25.

A very important and interesting piece of history worth knowing and appreciating by all believers. And may it *challenge* us to spend quality time in this same glorious book that this great servant literally gave his life for.

Today it's hard to imagine the world without an English Bible, and there could now be as many as 900 of such translations in existence – but before Tyndale it had never happened. He's known as the Father of the English Bible, since the later, epochal work of the King James Version of the Bible largely consisted of Tyndale's scholarly and accessible translations.

The English language, as with scholarly understanding, continues to evolve – and so the work of Bible translation continues today. But without the courage and genius of men like Tyndale, who challenged the status quo before them and died for doing so, it might never have been possible.

FACTS

1. God sees every person as being "in Adam"—in Adam's family, or "*in Christ*"—in Christ's family.

Moses—the man who chose God

When Moses was 40 years old, he went out to his people, the children of Israel. He saw their hardships. One day he saw an Egyptian slave master beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. Moses killed the Egyptian and hid his body in the sand. Moses chose to identify himself with the children of Israel, a race of slaves at that time. The Bible says, "*By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season*" (Hebrews 11:24-25).

When the Egyptians discovered what he had done, Moses had to run for his life. He went into the land of Midian and lived there with the priest of Midian. Moses became a shepherd. The priest of Midian gave one of his daughters to Moses to be his wife. **In Egypt** the children of Israel were slaves of Pharaoh and idol worshippers. They were bowing down before Egypt's gods. They had hard, merciless taskmasters who beat them daily with whips.

Yet they had their little pleasures. Pharaoh allowed them to have fish, cucumbers, melons, onions and garlic. This helped make them content to remain in Egypt as Pharaoh's slaves.

This is a picture of every unsaved person. He is a slave of Satan in Satan's world system. Yet, Satan allows him to have his little pleasures in the world because they help to keep him content to remain Satan's slave, in Satan's world system. Because of their great suffering, the children of Israel cried out to God, and God heard their groaning and their cries. God appeared to Moses in the wilderness and said, "*I am come down to deliver them.*"

How did God deliver His people? He gave them a deliverer—Moses. Moses was raised in the royal palace as the son of Pharaoh's daughter. He was in line to become a ruler of Egypt. He had everything that this world could offer him, but God called him to identify himself with the children of Israel, a slave race.

Moses refused Egypt's greatness, wealth and pleasures, and chose to obey God. Pleasing God and obeying Him was more important to Moses than "*enjoying the pleasure of sin for a season.*" The Bible says, "*By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing Him [God] who is invisible*" (Hebrews 11:27).

It pleases God when we, like Moses, refuse the sinful pleasures of this world and choose to serve Him. God has great rewards for us in the next world.

TURN BACK TO GOD

Prophecies The Antichrist Will Fulfil- Part 1



1. The Antichrist will be a man – Daniel 7:24-25
2. He will confirm a covenant for 7 years – Daniel 9:27
Now also, this does not mean that he creates this covenant. The word here for "confirm" is 1396 gabar (gaw-bar'); a primitive root; to be strong; by implication, to prevail, act insolently: KJV– exceed, confirm, be great, be mighty, prevail, put to more [strength], strengthen, be stronger, be valiant. The Antichrist will strengthen a covenant for a 7 year time span. Now this could be an existing covenant (like the Jerusalem Covenant) or a new covenant drawn up at that time.
3. He will rise among 10 kings – Daniel 7:8
This 10 nation union will be a revived Holy Roman Empire – Daniel 2:44
4. He will uproot 3 kings from the original 10 kings to gain political power – Daniel 7:8
5. His 10 nation union will merge into a world government which he will dominate – Revelations 13:1-2
Now this also, could refer to several things. First, the 10 nations could merge into an EXISTING world government, such as the U.N. Or it could be for a new world government, much like the U.N. Or, this 10 nation confederation could be something like the new 10 nation common stock market. A union like this would definitely rule the world, without having a "seat" of power. Whoever controls the money, controls the globe.
6. He will ascend to power on a platform of peace. By peace, he will destroy many – Daniel 8:25
7. He will be promoted and exalted by a miracle-working religious partner (false prophet) – Revelations 13:11-12
8. He was, and is not, and yet is – Revelations 17:8
More than likely this is referring to political power. The Antichrist will have ruled, but then be taken out of power. Only to rise back up again to power as the head of the One World Government.
9. The world government over which he rules will be a red (communistic or socialistic) government – Revelations 17:14
10. The Antichrist will be preceded by 7 kings or rulers. He will be the 8th king. He will also be "of" the 7 – Revelations 17:11

Now this scripture has many different ways it can be viewed. The word "goeth" in the scripture is 5217 hupago (hoop-ag'-o); from 5259 and 71; to lead (oneself) under, i.e. withdraw or retire (as if sinking out of sight), literally or figuratively: KJV– depart, get hence, go (a-) way. So we see that he will withdraw or retire from sight. But will rise back up again to power. Now this could be taken as to mean 7 kings. Or this could be taken as 7 World Governments that have ruled. So far there have been 6. 1. Egypt. 2. Assyria. 3. Babylon. 4. Medo-Persia. 5. Greece. 6. Rome

11. He will have a mouth speaking great things. Very boastful – Daniel 7:8
12. His look will be more stout than his fellows – Daniel 7:20
The word "stout" means 7227 rab (rab); by contracted from 7231; abundant (in quantity, size, age, number, rank, quality): KJV– (in) abound (-undance, -ant, -antly), captain, elder, enough, exceedingly, full, great (-ly, man, one), increase, long (enough, [time]), (do, have) many (-ifold, things, a time), ([ship-]) master, mighty, more, (too, very) much, multiply (-tude), officer, often [-times], plenteous, populous, prince, process [of time], suffice (-lent). So this can have several meanings. It could mean one of the following:
the Antichrist will be larger in size than everybody else, will be older than everybody else, will have more of a "following" than anybody else, is a higher military or political rank than anybody else, or is more qualified than anybody else.
Whatever this verse is speaking about, it is obvious when you look at him. (Continue next edition)

HOW DO YOU RESPOND WHEN PEOPLE LEAVE YOU*

John 6:66-67: from this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him. 67 "You do not want to leave too, do you?" Jesus asked the Twelve.

Do you get bitter, angry and feel disappointed when people leave your life, leave your company or leave your church? I don't know for you, but I have felt all of the above. There is that feeling of guilt and condemnation whenever people leave you. You start asking what exactly have you done wrong that made certain people to leave.

Husbands and wives ask those questions when one of the spouse leaves the marriage. A boyfriend or girlfriend feels the same when the fiancée leaves for another.

Pastors feel the same when certain key member of their church leaves to join another church or start his own ministry.

All of us desire permanent loyalty from other people whether in a marriage relationship, a work place, in business or the ministry.

Unfortunately there is nothing like permanent loyalty with people, and God never promised that. The only person that guarantees us His permanent loyalty is God. He promised never to leave us nor forsake us. He is as constant as the northern star. You may leave Him, but He will never leave you.

With all the anointing and supernatural evidences of His ministry with signs and wonders following, Jesus lost a whole congregation of more than five thousand in one day and was left with only twelve members.

Think about that for a moment! Some of us would have had a heart attack through disappointment and bitterness. If that would have happened in our time today, we would have considered Jesus to be a big failure in ministry. But Jesus' response was simple, He turned and asked His disciples, "You do not want to leave too, do you?"

Honestly, I don't think I would have done that. Rather, I would have sent the twelve to do a massive follow up on those that have left or organize another healing and miracle crusade to grow the church again.

Probably out of bitterness and anger, I would have rained down curses on those people for being too quick to forget the miracle sandwich they just ate the previous day. But Jesus did none of that. Rather, He accepted it in good faith and was never bitter and angry against those that have left His ministry.

This should be a learning curve for each of us especially those of us in ministry who are either General Overseers or senior pastors. Let us learn to allow people to leave who want to leave without getting bitter and angry.

Because no matter what you do as a leader, people will one day leave your church or your ministry. If they left Jesus, they will leave you.

So be of good cheer and be encouraged by that.

John Knox prayed: "Lord, Give me Scotland or I die"...
St Patrick, a rugged believer that Brought even dead animals and trees back to life prayed: "God, Give me souls or give me nothing else"....

Brethren, The Hebrides revival prayed:" Lord, If you will not use us, please, kill us"...

The brethren from England who brought the Fire from Azusa Street revival gathered everyday under the terrible cold. Their only prayer topic was: "Lord, give us men that will spread Your Fire in the streets of England".
