Discover the purpose of your escape and pay attention to it; discover the divine purpose that does not allow God to hand you over to the wishes of the enemy.

Discover the divine purpose for which heaven will not allow you to be a victim.


Your destiny is big; there is a place you are going to.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

TOPIC: HOW IDOLS AFFECTED ISRAELITES IN THE LAND OF CANAAN

TEXT: Judges 2:6-23, 3:1-15

MEMORY VERSE: Judges 2:11-12 KJVS

[11] And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord, and served Baalim: [12] And they forsook the Lord God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the Lord to anger.

INTRODUCTION: When the children of Israel got to the Promised Land, even Canaan, Joshua, their leader commanded them to serve the Lord always when he renewed the covenant of God with them at Shechem. (Joshua 24:1-28). After his death, they continue to serve the Lord their God (Joshua 24:31). But soon after the death of the elders who outlived Joshua, the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord and served Baalim... (Judges 2:10-23). These are the issues we will dwell on in these lessons.

LESSON

THE ISRAELITES FORSOOK THE LORD (PART ONE)

- They served the Lord all the days of Joshua and the elders who outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the Lord that he did for Israel.

- The Lord sold the Israelites unto the hand of the king of Mesopotamia. How many years did they serve him?
 - o Who delivered them?
 - o How many years of reprieve do they have after the deliverance according to Judges 3:9-11?

- After the forty (40) years of rest and the death of Othniel the son of Kenaz, the children of Israel again did evil and the Lord strengthened their enemy against them.
 - o Do you believe God can still do the same today?
- How many years did they serve the Moabites and who delivered them?
- According to Judges 3:15-31, how did He deliver them? Who was Shamgar the son of Anath?

CONCLUSION: "And if thy people Israel be put to the worse before the enemy because they have sinned against thee and shall return and confess thy name and pray and make supplication before thee in this house; Then hear thou from the heavens and forgive the sin of the people of Israel and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest to them and their fathers" (II Chronicles 6:24-25). "If my people who are called by my name shall humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways then will I hear from heaven and will heal their land." (II Chronicles 7:14). Our God is a compassionate Father. Hallelujah! Amen.

Sisters, Remind your husband that his mother is the treasure of his life, and his heaven.


Do not distract him from his Mother.

PERSONAL ENEMY #1

Putting us in Christ was God's work. Why did God put us in Christ? He put us in Christ so that He could deal with that old, sinful self that is the cause of so much of our troubles. God put us in Christ on the cross so that we were crucified with Him. In going to the cross, the Lord Jesus not only took our sins, but He also took us. The Bible says, "Our old self was crucified with him" (Romans 6:6).

Because of the extreme hatefulness of self, God had to use some extreme measures. He brought our old self-life to an end on the cross.



But something else happened. Not only were we in Christ when He was crucified, but we were with Him when He arose. The Bible says God, "made us alive with Christ...and...raised us up with Christ..." (Ephesians 2:5-6) God gave us a new life in Christ!

The Lord Jesus Christ did not die just to save us from hell. He died to save us from ourselves as well. He died that we might have a **new centre—Christ**.

The Bible says, "For this very reason, Christ died and returned to life so that he might be the Lord..." (Romans 14:9) Get that straight—"that He might be the Lord." In plain, simple language that means "the Boss of your life"—the One who makes the decisions and gives the orders. The Bible says of those who are raised up to new life in Christ, "that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again." (2 Corinthians 5:15)

When the Lord Jesus takes His rightful place as Lord of our lives, things will be different. Instead of the ugly manifestations of the self-life, our lives will show forth the wonderful fruit of the Spirit—"love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control." (Galatians 5:22-23)

Folake, a primary school teacher, was transferred to a different school and immediately appointed as a class teacher of a class five class. On her first day in her class, she noticed that a boy named Kola was different from the rest of the pupils because he was always lonely, out of place, dirty and never used to do homework. Folake also realized that most pupils in the class had a negative attitude towards him. Folake decided to investigate and find out the problem. He doesn't do his homework and has very few friends". By now teacher Folake had known where the problem was, and she was very ashamed of herself. And from that day onwards she decided to pay much attention on Kola and to assist him as much as possible.

Towards the end of the year, the pupils in the class decided to bring presents to teacher Folake. All the pupils in the class brought expensive presents which were wrapped in coloured paper except Kola. His present was wrapped clumsily in old pieces of newspaper. The rest of the pupils laughed at him when they saw what he brought. Folake felt great pain as she opened the present that Kola had brought, she found an old bottle of perfume which was a quarter full and an old bracelet which had several beads missing. To stifle the laughter from the pupils, teacher Folake exclaimed "this bracelet is very beautiful" and wore it. She also took the bottle of perfume, tapped it on her wrist and put it on.

In the evening, when the rest of the pupils were going home, Kola deliberately remained behind, and when he was sure that all the pupils had left, he went to see teacher Folake. He entered her office, and summoning enough courage he said to her, "teacher, today you smelled the way my mum used to". When Kola left, Folake locked herself in the office and cried for more than an hour. The following year, Kola wrote a letter to teacher FOLAKE. He told her that she was the best teacher that he ever had in his life.

Six years later, he wrote another letter, he told her that he had finished secondary school and he was the best in his class. He added that "she was still the best teacher he ever had in his life". Eight years later, he wrote another letter. He told her that he had completed his bachelor's degree in medicine was now a doctor. He added that she was still "the best teacher he ever had in his life".

The following year, he wrote another letter. He told her that he had found a girl and was going to get married. He explained that his father had died one year earlier, and was wondering whether Folake would accept to attend the wedding and sit in the place reserved for the mother of the groom. Of course Folake accepted and during the wedding, she was putting on the same bracelet with several beads missing and she was also putting on the same perfume that Kola remembered his mother was putting on the day she died. Now I ask a question, have you ever helped someone you don't like? Can you do good just to help someone get up even when they cannot pay you back when they are not there?

God Is There

Aubrey bought a fleece-lined coat for her aging father, but he died before he could wear it. So she tucked a note of encouragement with a \$20 bill into the pocket and donated the jacket to charity.

Ninety miles away, unable to endure his family's dysfunction any longer, nineteen-year-old Kelly left his house without grabbing a coat. He knew of only one place to turn—the home of his grandmother who prayed for him. Hours later he stepped off a bus and into his grandma's arms. Shielding him from the winter wind, she said, "We've got to get you a coat!" At the mission store, Kelly tried on a coat he liked. Slipping his hands into the pockets he found an envelope—with a \$20 bill and Aubrey's note.

Jacob fled his dysfunctional family in fear for his life (Genesis 27:41–45). When he stopped for the night, God revealed Himself to Jacob in a dream. "I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go," God told him (28:15). Jacob vowed, "If God will . . . give me food to eat and clothes to wear . . . , then the Lord will be my God" (vv. 20–21).

Jacob made a rudimentary altar and named the spot "God's house" (v. 22). Kelly takes Aubrey's note and that \$20 wherever he goes. Each serves as a reminder that no matter where we run, God is there.

When you've had to "run," whether literally or metaphorically, where did you go and to whom did you turn? How can you remind yourself of God's presence in your life? Father, You're the One I can always run to. Help me turn to You first.

The significance of the words, "All peoples on earth will be blessed through you and your offspring" (Genesis 28:14), must not be lost in the dynamics of Jacob's dream. Jacob wasn't the first to hear God's promise concerning the destiny of his offspring. Similar words were communicated to Jacob's grandfather, Abraham, in Genesis 12:3 (see also 22:16–18) and to Isaac (26:3–4). In the New Testament, Peter pointed to this promise in his preaching (Acts 3:25–26; see Genesis 22:18; 26:4). Paul's writings similarly show that these promises found their ultimate fulfillment in Jesus (Galatians 3:16).

LAST WORD

Abundance of life or the good things of life is not power nor by might, but is instead enabled by the spirit of God.

The power to receive and operate in abundance resides with God through His Son Jesus Christ. Therefore, abundance in any area of life is not by a dint of hard work, human wisdom or intellect. Instead, it is by the grace of God of heaven.

Abundance can only be attained, achieved and sustained by God Almighty; the great God, that gives His grace to as many He decides to give.

Remember! The bible says, "By strength shall no man prevail." another scripture says, "It is not of him that willeth or of him that runneth, but of the Lord that shows mercy."

From the above scripture, we come to realize it is not by human expertise or natural ability.

Instead, only God has the discretion to determine abundance. You might be energetic and intellectually inclined, yet, without having abundance. Meanwhile, these are the criteria the people of the world view as ticket to abundance.

We have seen jobless engineers. Sometimes, there are professionals who are drunkards.

There are other categories of workers/businessmen who labour daily over the years, but have failed to achieve abundance, the physical energy they expend notwithstanding. There are many people who are well informed, enlightened and laced with various degrees of educational qualifications and occupy high social stratum but yet have not recorded any meaningful achievement that can be interpreted as abundance.

Maybe you desire to take advantage of this month to achieve abundance in your life.

It is very possible as long as you recognize that you have the power to do all things through Christ which strengtheneth you. Your ability to do all things cannot be separated from the Lord. So, begin afresh to seek God, because He is the Giver of abundance. Seeking Him begins when you make a re-evaluation of your relationship and arrive at the conclusion there is need to reconcile with Him through His Son Jesus Christ. In this direction, you must repent of all your sins, give your life to Jesus Christ and accept Him as your Lord and personal Saviour.

That way, you stand on a legal ground to seek for the abundance of God's blessings.
