FAITH CLINIC

We live in a fast-moving and often brutal world, often forced to live at a pace that leaves us breathless. We easily tire under the weight of life's competing demands. So many of the prayer requests I receive reflect today's challenge of affordable rent, employment opportunities and financial stability. It is evident we have to navigate our way through a pressured life that increasingly challenges our mental health. Recently I received notice from a credit agency that I owed my old mobile phone company money. It was a small sum, around £28. I wanted to challenge this since I'd cancelled my account appropriately. Then the problems began. Firstly, there was no phone number to talk to a fellow human. After trying to talk to a human being, eventually I paid up, under the threat of further penalty charges. Fortunately God is not some unreachable rule-enforcer. He is a personal friend who works with us. I am supported in learning more about who I am, and introduced into a community of other people, each one pursuing God and finding connection with the divine promise through encounter with God and participation within the community of God's faithful. As I feel increasingly alienated from a world that demands so much of me, I grow closer to God. Yet the world that pressures me finds it difficult to embrace the God I worship. So even my faith choices place me at odds with society; another potential source of pressure. The way I choose to live lies within my own gift. I accept God's compassion and love. The flood waters of circumstance may be licking at the threshold of my life, yet I can find peace and confidence in God.

THE MANIFESTATION GIFTS XVIII

Joel 2:27-29

MEMORY VERSE: "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and daughters shall prophecy, your old men shall see visions." Joel 2:28.

INTRODUCTION: In the last lesson, we concluded discussion on the manifestation gifts. To crown it all, we want to look at the gifts which are not spiritual gifts, hindrances to the functioning of the manifestation gifts of the Holy Spirit within the Local Church and some Bible regulations on the Biblical gifts.

LESSON VI. HINDRANCES TO THE FUNCTIONING OF THE MANIFESTATION GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT WITHIN THE LOCAL CHURCH

1. Ignorance of the gifts
2. Lack of knowledge on how the gifts function
3. Unfavourable conditions in the Church
 - a. Give some examples of unfavourable conditions in the Church that may hinder the functioning of these gifts within the Local Church.

SOME REGULATIONS ON BIBLICAL GIFTS

The Bible regulates and laid principles for three things in the Church, which are:

1. Tongues and interpretation of tongues. I Cor. 14:26-28
2. The Prophets. I Cor. 14:29-33
3. The position of women in the Church. I Cor. 14:34-38.

GIFTS WHICH ARE NOT SPIRITUAL GIFTS


The following gifts, grace or natural abilities are not spiritual gifts. There is nowhere they are mentioned as part of the Spiritual Gifts assigned by the Holy Spirit to the Church.

1. Prayer. Luke 18:1, I Tess. 5:17
 - a. All are to pray without fainting, without ceasing and at any time.
 - b. We receive the grace to pray more than others when we allow the Holy Spirit to fill us
 - c. There are different grace to how we pray
2. Dream.
 - a. Dream is not a spiritual gift.
 - b. The old men and women are to dream dreams because of their experience
 - c. God can speak to anybody and do speak to virtually everybody through dreams, to give us a revelation. We are bound to dream because we have souls. Eccl. 5:3
3. Singspiration or singing
 - a. This is a talent or one of the natural abilities or the inner or inborn grace.
4. Trance, vision and revelation
 - a. They are not spiritual gifts but a bye product of the Spiritual Gifts.
 - b. Trance is a vision seen or vision we saw when we opened our eyes (Num. 24:4, Daniel 5:5-29, Acts 10:9-13). Vision is what we see or vision we saw when we close our eyes while praying. Revelation could be what was revealed to us in our dream or short sleep while in prayer.
 - c. The gifts of word of knowledge, wisdom and discerning of spirits can be manifested through vision.
5. Palm reading, ball gazing, star gazing, mind reading, sand pressing etc.
 - a. They are not spiritual spirits but occultism.

NOTE: To go into trance, see vision and revelation is due to the way a person gives himself to God in much praying and fasting, but every true child of God is expected to be led or directed by the Holy Spirit of God and not by seeing vision or relying on someone's prophecy.

CONCLUSION: We have come to the end of section two on the manifestation gifts. The next section will treat the service gifts.



The arrival of our third child Jeremy did not go as smoothly as our first two. Shortly after birth he was diagnosed with an infection which would require a course of antibiotics. The memory of accompanying the doctor to the intensive care unit and watching him attempt to insert a cannula needle into the tiny wrist of our baby boy is forever imprinted on my memory. I was tasked with feeding Jeremy with drops of sugary water as the doctor manipulated his wrist, attempting several times to find a suitable vein that would allow passage for the antibiotics to enter his system and flush out the infection. But no amount of sucrose solution from my plastic syringe could undo the fact that it was a painful business. How I wished I could explain to my bawling new-born, not yet 24 hours old, that the doctor wasn't being horrid, he was being helpful. That the pain of the needle was necessary. That this wouldn't last forever. That I loved him.

Since that day (and with Jeremy now a healthy, boisterous 5-year-old) I have often thought about the way that experience could be compared to the way we are often unable to recognise the purposes that may accompany suffering in our own lives. We are not able to see the big picture in the way that God sees it. We see only the present pain, the sting of the needle. God is the parent who is with us in our suffering, yet also sees the end from the beginning in ways that we cannot fathom.

Yet, before we present any apologetic on pain, it's important to remember that people who are actually going through suffering need our love, not our logic. They need someone to sit and weep with them, not to present a three-point sermon on why God allows evil.

So, in presenting three reasons why God may allow suffering to touch our lives, please consider these responses a later step in the pastoral conversation, when the questions often turn to 'Why would God allow suffering?'

1. BECAUSE GOD WON'T ROB US OF FREE WILL

The problem of suffering is usually posed as a question: 'If God is all-powerful and all good, why does he allow evil to exist in the world?' Perhaps the most common response is known as the 'free will defence'. After all, where does most of the evil in this world come from?

Much of it is a direct consequence of our wrong choices as human beings. Yet one of the greatest goods that God has given us is free will – the ability to choose between right and wrong. The problem is that many people choose to do evil rather than good.

Imagine if God intervened at every moment anyone was going to make a wrong choice. Free will would no longer exist. If God waved his magic wand every time we made a bad choice, we would merely be puppets controlled by a puppeteer who overruled our thoughts and actions.

Would we want to live in such a world, even if it meant we were insulated from suffering? Could we even speak of concepts such as 'love' without it being something freely given, and freely rejected?

The great gift of freedom and love that God has given us comes at the cost of the evil that people freely choose to carry out in the world.

The critic of Christianity will be quick to reply, 'That may be. But there is also much suffering that exists in the world which isn't a result of our own actions.' Think of natural disasters, disease and illness. Often these are termed 'natural evil' and presented as a serious challenge to the concept of a loving God.

'Suffering has been stronger than all other teaching...I have been bent and broken, but – I hope – into a better shape' Charles Dickens

'You can never learn that Christ is all you need, until Christ is all you have' Corrie Ten Boom

'Nothing in all creation can separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord' (Romans 8:39) St Paul

However, even in these cases we shouldn't be too hasty to discount the consequences of the misuse of our human freedom.

The Haiti earthquake which caused so much death and suffering in 2010 was no more violent than the ones which often strike places such as Los Angeles with little or no loss of life. The difference is that compared to Haiti, the US is a rich and prosperous country with the necessary resources for earthquake-proofed buildings, emergency services and infrastructure.

The fact is that collective human choices have resulted in a world of haves and have-nots – where the impact of natural disasters and disease will very much depend on where you are born in the world. Our free will still makes a huge difference to the toll of natural evil. We can't always lay the blame at God's door.

2. BECAUSE WE LIVE IN A BROKEN WORLD

But why has God allowed death, disease and natural disaster to exist at all? This question can only be answered by a Christian from within their own worldview, and means we must expand our perspective to a cosmic scale.

The apostle Paul states that 'We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time' (Romans 8:22). We believe, then, that the whole created order is in some sense 'out of kilter' at a cosmic level. Some theologians trace this to human rebellion – an outworking of 'the fall' which acts both forwards and backwards in time. Others point to the existence of an earlier rebellion in the angelic realm that sparked a 'cosmic fall' (hinted at in Revelation 12:9).

Whatever the origin, the result is a world that is not as it should be. Yet Paul includes the promise that one day 'the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God' (Romans 8:21).

So we live in the tension of a broken world that is awaiting renewal. The natural laws that operate are both a blessing and a curse. Tectonic plate activity renews the surface of the earth with minerals, yet wreaks havoc when humans build cities on the fault lines. Cell replication allows our bodies to grow and develop, yet can result in cancer when natural processes misfire. Death is a necessary part of the cycle of life, yet still remains our 'last enemy' (1 Corinthians 15:26).

As Christians we are called to live faithfully for the kingdom that has already come in Jesus, while awaiting the kingdom yet to be in which "He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death" or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away' (Revelation 21:4).

3. BECAUSE SUFFERING CAN DRAW PEOPLE TO GOD

Underlying many people's questions about suffering is an assumption about God's purpose in creating us. We must ask the question 'what does a loving God want for the human beings he created?' Here are two possible answers: It's God's job to keep human beings happy, comfortable and pain-free. That's what a lot of people assume is meant by God being 'loving'.

But there is another possible answer: God's purpose for human beings is to bring them to know and love him.

Those are two very different responses. Coming to know and love God may be quite different to him keeping us comfortable and happy.

The reality is that comfort tends to make us forget about God. It's evidenced by a prosperous Western world where belief in God is increasingly absent. Yet Christianity often thrives in places which are experiencing the fires of persecution or hardship.

For some, suffering leads to an abandonment of belief in God, but for many the opposite is true – it causes them to seek God in a world that seems absurd without him. Many people have counted pain and suffering as a crucial part of their journey towards Christianity. CS Lewis wrote in *The Problem of Pain*, 'God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks in our conscience, but shouts in our pain: it is His megaphone to rouse a deaf world.'

By the same token, it can be argued that meaningful moral and spiritual growth as human beings requires a world where some suffering exists. I cannot be generous unless there is someone who has less than me. I cannot show compassion unless there is someone who needs caring for.


While I don't believe that God directly causes pain and suffering, I do believe that God is masterful enough to weave all the experiences and tribulations of our life into a tapestry that is ultimately beautiful and, if we allow him, draws us towards being the people he wants us to be.

Do these brief reasons answer all the questions posed by suffering? Of course not. There is much more that could be said, a great deal of mystery, and many more questions that could be asked. For instance, could God have created a possible world in which pain and suffering do not exist and still fulfil our human needs?

Perhaps. But what if we are already living in the best of all possible worlds this side of heaven? That may seem an absurd suggestion when we look at all the suffering and evil on our earth. Yet I would argue that a world in which Jesus stepped into his broken creation and freely gave his life on the cross to demonstrate the supreme love of God, is in fact the best possible kind of world we could hope for.

It tells the wonderful story of how God's Son left His home in Heaven and came down to this world to be born as a tiny baby.

When Jesus grew up, He humbled Himself to serve people. He said, *"The Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister [serve], and to give His life a ransom for many"* (Matthew 20:28).

Jesus humbled Himself to do a slave's job— He washed the feet of His disciples.

Finally, He *"humbled Himself, and became obedient [to His Father's will] unto death, even the death of the cross"* (Philippians 2:8).

He did it because it was His Father's will. He said, *"...not My will, but Yours, be done"* (Luke 22:42).

TURN BACK TO GOD

Cursing is Satan's Job



When we curse others we want Satan's wish to be done in others' lives. But I say to you, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hate you" (Lk 6:27).

It is natural for us to wish a person evil if he/she does us some bad. This wishing evil whether done aloud or silent, is called **cursing**.

When we curse a person in mind or in words we are telling that, he/she may experience something bad in his life.

But God does not want that person to experience anything bad in his/her life. Even though that person has hurt us and hurt God, what God wants is good things in their life.

Cursing is telling Satan's wish to take place

But irrespective of what that person does, what Satan wants in his/her life is only evil. So if we curse a person that an evil thing must happen in his/her life we are indirectly telling that only Satan's wish and not God's wish must take place in that person's life.

As a child of God, I should never say that Satan's wish must take place. This is the reason we pray, "Your will be done as it is in heaven." A person who prays like this cannot curse a person.

As a child of God, if someone does me any harm, I must bless him/her, for in this way I wish that God's will be done in his/her life, and that Satan's wish may not take place in his life. So **watch your words**.

As a child of God, I should not curse anyone who does me any harm, for as a child of God I cannot think of wishing that Satan's wish may take place however sad I am.

I cannot complain to God that this person has done me some wrong, as long as I wish that Satan's wish may take place in his/her life.

When somebody does us harm we must tell God that he/she has hurt me, so God bless him/her so that this person will do only the things you want him to do i.e. doing good to me and to all others, so that this person will experience only those things which God wants him/her to experience.

Blessing my enemy only good is my right and my duty, for how can I as a child of God wish that my father's will may not take place; how can I as a child of God wish that Satan's wish may be fulfilled.



If you had a bank that credited your account each morning with \$86,400—with no balance carried from day to day—what would you do? How would you spend your money?

Well, you do have such a bank...time. Every morning, time credits you with 86,400 seconds to use for whatever purpose you choose. Every night it rules off as "lost" whatever you have failed to use toward good purposes. It carries over no balances and allows no overdrafts. You can't hoard it, save it, store it, loan it, or invest it. You can only use it.

"I Was Just Thinking About Time. Use it Wisely!"

Arthur Berry was described by Time as "the slickest second-story man in the East," truly one of the most famous jewel thieves of all times. In his years of crime, he committed as many as 150 burglaries and stole jewels valued between \$5 and \$10 million. He seldom robbed from anyone not listed in the Social Register and often did his work in a tuxedo.

On an occasion or two, when caught in the act of a crime by a victim, he charmed his way out of being reported to the police. Like most people who engage in a life of crime, he was eventually caught, convicted and served 25 years in prison for his crimes. Following his release, he worked as a counterman in a roadside restaurant on the East Coast for \$50 a week.

A newspaper reporter found him and interviewed him about his life. After telling about the thrilling episodes of his life he came to the conclusion of the interview saying, "I am not good at morals. But early in my life I was intelligent and clever, and I got along well with people.

I think I could have made something of my life, but I didn't. So when you write the story of my life, when you tell people about all the burglaries, don't leave out the biggest one of all...Don't just tell them I robbed Jesse Livermore, the Wall Street baron or the cousin of the king of England. You tell them Arthur Berry robbed Arthur Berry."

First: Nobody can manage time. But you can manage those things that take up your time.

Second: Time is expensive. As a matter of fact, 80 percent of our day is spent on those things or those people that only bring us two percent of our results.

Third: Time is perishable. It cannot be saved for later use.

Fourth: Time is measurable. Everybody has the same amount of time...pauper or king. It is not how much time you have; it is how much you use.

Fifth: Time is irreplaceable. We never make back time once it is gone.

Sixth: Time is a priority. You have enough time for anything in the world, so long as it ranks high enough among your priorities.

Just think about the familiar complaint, "If I just had more time."

This is exceedingly self-deceptive! Kings have no more time, beggars no less!

God gives to every man 24 golden hours per day. That's 86,400 precious seconds ticket inexorably away.

Here's the point: If you don't manage time, time will manage you.
