Bearing One Another's Burdens

Galatians 6:1-5

At some point, all of us struggle under the weight of a difficult situation. It might be a sin we cannot overcome, a trial that just doesn't let up, or a need that remains unmet.

However, there's no need to struggle through it alone, because we have the support of fellow believers as we bear one another's burdens. There is an example of this in the book of Acts.

Christians of the early church pooled their resources to help meet the material and financial needs of believers who were in poverty (Acts 4:32-35).

Paul also displays this concern for others' welfare in his various letters to growing churches. He knew it was his responsibility and privilege to strengthen them even though he was repeatedly undergoing his own hardships and afflictions.

Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.
Galatians 6:2

We can't wait until life is free from problems before reaching out to others—that day may never come. Though every one of us has his or her own needs, it's important to remember we can do all things through Christ's strength. And that includes sharing someone else's burden.

When we're willing to wade into a fellow believer's troubles to help, that person is blessed, and we're fulfilling the Lord's command to love our neighbour as ourselves.

All Fused Bulbs are the Same!

A senior executive retired and shifted from his palatial official quarters to the housing society, whereby he owned a flat. He considered himself big and never talked to anyone. Even while walking in the society park every evening, he ignored others, looking at them with contempt.

One day, it somehow transpired that an elderly person sitting beside him started a conversation, and they continued to meet. Every conversation was mostly a monologue with the retired executive harping on his pet topic, "Nobody can imagine the big post and high position I held before retirement; I came here due to compulsions"; and so on, and the other elderly person used to listen to him quietly.

After many days, when the retired executive was inquisitive about others, the elderly listener opened his mouth and said, "After retirement, we are all like fused bulbs. It does not matter what a bulb's wattage was, how much light or glitter it gave, after it gets fused."

He continued, "I have been living in this society for the last 5 years and have not told anyone that I was a Member of the Parliament for two terms. On your right, over there is Vermaji, who retired as General Manager in Indian Railways. Over there is Singh Saheb, who was a Major General in the Army.

That person sitting on the bench in spotless white dress is Mehraji, who was the chief of ISRO before retirement. He hasn't revealed it to anyone, not even to me, but I know."

"All fused bulbs are now the same – whatever its wattage was – 0, 10, 40, 60, 100 watts – it doesn't matter now.

Neither does it matter what type of bulb it was before it got fused – *LED, CFL, Halogen, Incandescent, fluorescent, or decorative.*

And that, my friend, applies to you too.

The day you understand this, you will find peace and tranquillity even in this housing society."

"The rising sun as well as the setting sun are both beautiful and adorable. But, in reality, the rising sun gets more importance and adoration, and is even worshipped, whereas the setting sun is not given the same reverence.

It is better to understand this sooner than later". Our current designation, title and power are not permanent. Keeping lot of emotions with these things only complicate our life when we lose this one day.

TOPIC: GOD REVEALED HIMSELF TO ISRAEL AS THE ONLY TRUE GOD IX

TEXT: Exodus 20:1-5, 23:20-25:32-33, Deuteronomy 5:6-10

MEMORY VERSE: Deuteronomy 7:9-11 KJVS

[9] Know therefore that the Lord thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; [10] And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face. [11] Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them.

INTRODUCTION: As soon as the children of Israel were liberated from Egypt, God told them why He did all the signs in Egypt and to all Egyptians and admonished them to obey and keep His commandments, thereby they shall be a peculiar treasure, a kingdom of priests and a holy nation. God, therefore, came down unto them with His commandments.

LESSON

GOD REVEALED HIMSELF TO ISRAEL IN THE WILDERNESS AND WARNED THEM AGAINST IDOL WORSHIPPING.

THE COMMANDMENTS

The commandments are ten in number but for this lesson, our focus will be the first two commandments.

- "... thou shall have no other gods before me" (Exodus 20:2-3). According to II Kings 17:27-33 and Zephaniah 1:2-6, the Israelites were not able to keep God's commandments over some time. Why? Discuss.
- Can the Church of today say, "For I have kept the way of the Lord and have not wickedly departed from my God...?" (II Samuel 22:22-24)? Discuss.
- Can you as a child of God say with all honesty the same? Yes/No. Explain.
- "Thou shall not make unto thee ..." (Exodus 20:4-5). According to Psalms 106:28-29, the children of Israel were not able to keep the commandment and they suffer the consequences but the Church of today is under grace not under the law or commandments. Which dispensation is easier and better, law or grace and why? Discuss.
- "Know therefore that the Lord thy God he is God, the faithful God ..." (Deuteronomy 7:9-20). Can we justify God for making all His promises conditional? Discuss.
- According to Exodus 23:20-23, 1. What three things must children of Israel do to the Angel of God?
2. What three things will the Angel of God who went before them do?
 - According to Exodus 23:25-28, what ten things did God promise to do if the children of Israel obeyed the Angel of God who went before them, in serving the Lord their God? Exodus 22:20, 23:13.
 - In Exodus 23:32-33, what must the children of Israel not do and what would happen if they do so?
 - In Deuteronomy 7:9-11, what are the attributes of God that manifested His faithfulness? Mention at least two.
 - What must we do to benefit from the faithfulness of God according to that passage?

"Thou shall therefore keep the commandments and the statutes and judgements which I command thee this day to do them. Thou shall be blessed above all people, there shall not be male or female barren among you or among your cattles." (Deuteronomy 7:11, 14). Amen.

God had shown him to me in my 200 level and I was waiting for him till 5 years later when he had finished his youth service and was working with a firm.

George and I used to go for ministrations together almost every weekends as he would always have invitations to preach in different programs. It was not a matter to me because I knew he is an Evangelist when God started telling me things about my husband back then in school. I was ready for the work though I thought it would be a full-time work. It was a horror story to me as I shouted, screamed, cried and I opened my eyes to look at him again and be sure it was not my imagination, I saw a spiritual giant that has been crashed. A man of God that was lifelessly dead in the Spirit. Just then, the great 10 year old question was called back to my memory "honey, can you wake me up if I die?"
With an understanding that came to me, I muttered "yes" as a reply. We cried together for hours and we continued later in the mid night because we had to cover up things for the kids. By the help of God, we started building again and God began to heal us together till I was able to wake him up from the dead.

Marriage is a very sweet relationship when you are married to your friend or the right person meant for you. But there is a question couples need to ask themselves. That is, "Honey, can you wake me up if I die?"
You may meet me very successful in Business, but a day may come and the business is dead, can you wake me up?

PERSONAL ENEMY #1

During the civil war in Spain a rebel general was outlining his plan for the conquest of Madrid. He explained, "I have four columns approaching the city—one from the north, one from the south, one from the east, and another from the west."

"Which one of these columns," asked a friend, "are you counting on to take the city?"

"None of these," replied the general. "The column I am depending on is my fifth column."

"And where is your fifth column?" asked the friend. "My fifth column," replied the general, "is in the city. I have men inside the city who are loyal to me. I am counting on them to deliver the city into my hands."



There is a lesson for Christians in this story. Every Christian can be likened to a city under attack. Our enemy, Satan, has many forces at his disposal, but the one that he counts on to bring about our defeat is his "fifth column"—**SELF**. Our self-centeredness provides opportunities for Satan to gain victories in our lives.

How did man become self-centred? To find the answer to this question, we must go back to the first man, **Adam**. As Adam came from the hand of God, he was God-centred. Adam's concern was to please God and to do God's will. God was the centre of his life; therefore, Adam had peace with himself and with God.

Then came that awful tragedy which theologians call "the fall of man." Adam rebelled against his Creator, and in so doing, he brought sin and death into the world. But something else happened. A fundamental change took place within Adam. He dethroned God in his heart and put self on the throne. This was Adam's great sin—rejecting God as the centre of his life and substituting self. Adam became self-centred instead of God-centred.



In time Adam died, but he passed his sinful nature on to his descendants and to the whole human race. The Bible says, "By one man's disobedience many were made sinners..." (Romans 5:19) Adam produced a race of self-centred people. One of our chief characteristics as members of Adam's fallen race is independence—we want our own way. Isaiah described the situation like this, "We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way..." (Isaiah 53:6) This wanting our own way instead of wanting God's way is the very essence of sin.

Instead of being God-centred as God intended man to be, man became self-centred. Instead of living to glorify his Creator, man lived to please himself. Instead of being ruled by God, man was ruled by self. Because man is ruled by self, he commits many sins. It is not at all difficult for us to see the sins of self in others, but it is very hard to see them in ourselves. Right now, let's take a good look at self and see if we do not recognize ourselves.

TURN BACK TO GOD

Let Us Forgive and Forget



It happened years back. I had a mild quarrel with my wife Stella. She came to me for a compromise but I was not ready. She apologized; still I was reluctant to forgive. Then she asked me a question: "What, if God does the same to you? If He is unmoved?"

These words flashed through my mind like a lightning. What will happen to me, if God is hesitant to forgive me? Wouldn't my life be a disaster if God did not forgive all the sins I committed through words and deeds all through my life. How can I wholeheartedly pray in this state; 'Forgive my sins as I forgive those who sin against me?'

Suddenly my anger and persistence melted and I was ready for a compromise.

Many people lose their peace of mind being hard heartened at the call of the Lord to repent. 

LAST WORD

The word of the Lord never goes back to him void. So whatever the Lord had promised concerning your life and mine shall come to pass in Jesus matchless name. Enjoy your day because you are more than a conqueror.

When you understand that life is a test, you realize that *nothing* is insignificant in your life. Even the smallest incident has significance for your character development. Every day is an important day, and every second is a growth opportunity to deepen your character, to develop your love, or to depend on God. Some tests seem overwhelming while others you don't even notice. But all of them have eternal implications.

The good news is that God wants you to pass the tests of life, so he never allows them to be greater than the grace he gives you to handle them. The Bible says, "God keeps his promise, and he will not allow you to be tested beyond your power to remain firm; at the time you are put to the test, he will give you the strength to endure it, and so provide you with a way out."⁴⁹

There are many people who are waiting for God to give them money. Sometimes, they refuse to work or engage in any form of economic activity believing that God will give them money. Oftentimes, they have become disappointed after waiting endlessly for God to send money to them.

Expecting God to give you wealth is not biblical. What God gives is the power or ability to make wealth. It is not that He cannot give wealth, but He prefers to give us the ability to make wealth by depositing certain gifts, talents and capabilities, which when harnessed properly paves the way for breakthrough and possessions.

Unfortunately, many people do not understand the correlation between the power to get wealth and actually getting wealth and therefore look unto God to give them wealth. God wants us to work and create wealth.

The bible says that anybody who does not work should not eat. This means that anyone who does not work does not deserve breakthrough or any possessions.

God has given us the recipe for wealth creation by revealing that He gives us power to create wealth. Therefore, the power to create wealth resides in you and requires activation for you to obtain breakthrough and possess your possessions. The power to make wealth does not reside in physical energy, but is determined by divine direction.

God is therefore directing our attention to the treasures of darkness and the riches in hidden places. (Isaiah 45:3) Treasures of darkness and riches in hidden places are not physical cash. Rather, they represent those opportunities that are hidden from the natural/carnal eyes; that when properly harnessed, will become wealth and riches.


