

Rev Dare Oluwaniyi. Passionate Obedience Acts 5:17-42

People who receive salvation and then sit back, content that they'll go to heaven when they die, have missed the point. Salvation isn't just about heaven; it also allows us to be used for God's glory here on earth. He lives through us, expressing His life-changing truth so that we can impact others. The only hindrance is the restriction we set on our own usefulness.


Limitations and passionate obedience can't coexist. Life might seem easier if we choose when to obey God, but that type of existence won't ever prove totally satisfying. Instead, we will tend to wonder why the Lord doesn't use us or bless us more.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

TOPIC: GOD REVEALED HIMSELF TO ISRAEL AS THE ONLY TRUE GOD VIII

TEXT: Exodus 6:1-13

MEMORY VERSE: Exodus 6:6-8 KJVS

[6] Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments: [7] And I will take you to me for a people, and I will be to you a God: and ye shall know that I am the Lord your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians. [8] And I will bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for a heritage: I am the Lord.

INTRODUCTION: After the children of Israel settled down in Egypt, Joseph, Pharaoh and all the elders died. The children of Israel multiplied, became fruitful and increased abundantly, then persecution and affliction started and they cried unto God for deliverance, God sent Moses to deliver them. The process of deliverance, why did God deliver is the focus today.

LESSON

'Watch your thoughts; they become words. Watch your words; they become actions. Watch your actions; they become habits. Watch your habits; they become character. Watch your character; it becomes your destiny'. I'm glad a friend forwarded this to me as a reminder and I chose to forward it to you. If you don't pass this on to anybody, nothing bad will happen to you; but, if you do, you would have ministered to someone today and God will bless you.*



Christ is everything.

We pray for power, or for purity, or for patience, but God doesn't send us little packages of these items. He has done far more. God has given us Christ, and everything we need is in Him. The Bible says, *"For in Christ there is all of God in a human body; so you have everything when you have Christ..."* (Colossians 2:9-10 The Living Bible)

It is not what we are that counts, it is what He is! The Bible says, *"It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption."* (1 Corinthians 1:30) He is all we need. When we need patience, He is our Patience. When we need purity, He is our Purity. And when we need power, He is our Power. He is to us whatever we need.

Christ is the answer.



How does this work out in everyday life?

Let us say that there is a certain person with whom you have always had difficulties. You know that you should be kind and loving toward him, but try as you will, your dislike for him always manages to show through. You grit your teeth and promise that you are going to control your feelings, but it does no good.

What is the solution? The solution is to remember that Jesus Christ lives in you. Do you think that He would be kind and loving to this person? Of course! Then, trust Him to do it. Just say to Him, *"Lord Jesus, I don't love this person as I should, but you live in me and you love him. I am trusting you to love him through me."* Then relax and trust Him to do it.

Perhaps there is some sin in your life which you are unable to control. Again, remember that **Christ lives in you**. Do you believe that He has all power in Heaven and earth as He said He had? Since He has all power in Heaven and earth, do you believe that He has power to set you free from that sin? Then, trust Him to do it. You trusted the crucified Saviour for the forgiveness of your sins. Now trust the risen Lord Jesus Christ who lives in you to break the power of this sin.

You may say, *"But I don't feel strong."* You aren't supposed to! Christ is the One who is strong—not you. God never promised to make us strong. He has given us Christ—He is our strength. As long as you are resting in what He is, nothing can touch you, not even the Devil himself! The Devil is powerful—much too powerful for us—but he is no match for Jesus Christ. The Bible says, *"the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world."* (1 John 4:4)

This is the great secret of the Christian life: **Christ lives within us**. Before you get out of bed in the morning, say to yourself, **"Christ lives in me."** Throughout the day, remind yourself, **"Christ lives in me."** Learn to count on His life in you. When you come up against something that you can't handle say, *"Lord I can't, but you can."*

Remember that the Lord Jesus is the Vine. We are the branches. He says to us, *"All that the vine is to the branches, I will be to you."* All a branch has to do is abide in the vine, and as it does so, it receives life each moment from the vine.

This is the Christian life—**Christ living His life in us**. This is God's way. This is what the world needs to see.

Here I am asked to give a speech at the funeral; yet the tears I cry are for how I failed my friend when my friend was still living. My friend is not coming back for me to love better. Maybe if I cared, things would have turned out different.

Look back and see the friends you have pushed away, ignored or taken for granted. Call up that old friend, care for the one who has gone silent. People are going through so many issues behind those fake smiles and glossy social media posts; And all they need is a true friend.

Be a ***TRUE FRIEND***.

Look for that friend who was in the school with you;
Look for that friend who served with you;
Look for that friend who sat next to you in the pew;

Two aspect of giving the other cheek.


In the Old Testament it is Moses law do me and do you. In other words the spirit of forgiveness was instantly lacking.



Those things you crave are already there for you. But then, you have to prioritize the kingdom of God over them. They should not take the centre stage.


