


"CALL UPON ME ON THE DAY OF TROUBLE"





SUNDAY SCHOOL

TOPIC: HOW IDOLS AFFECTED THE ISRAELITES IN THE LAND OF CANAAN IV

TEXT: I Samuel 7:1-17

MEMORY VERSE: **Jeremiah 10:10-11 KJVS**

[10] But the Lord is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. [11] Thus shall ye say unto them, the gods that have not made the heavens and the earth, even they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens?

INTRODUCTION: During the time of Eli the Priest at Shiloh, the devotion of the children of Israel to worship God was rekindled and it came to its peak during the time of Samuel, the Prophet of the Lord, and it was he that eventually turned the hearts of the people back to their God, he was the judge at the time. These are the issues we will consider in this lesson.

LESSON

THE ISRAELITES FORSOOK THE LORD (PART FOUR)

- Because of the sins of the house of Eli, the ark of the Lord was captured by the Philistines at Ebenezer and brought to Ashdod. (I Samuel 3:11-14, 4:1-11).
- What atrocities did the two sons of Eli commit according to I Samuel 2:12-17, 22-25?
 - What was their father's response when God sent a man of God to Eli the Priest? I Samuel 2:22-25: 27.
- Was God justified in His judgement against the house of Eli the Priest and his two sons? I Samuel 2:27-36.
- If you are Eli the Priest, what will you do to your children or how will you handle Hophni and Phinehas?
- How can the Church of the living God handle today's generation of Hophni and Phinehas polluting the sacrifices of God?
- When the house of Israel lamented after the Lord, Samuel the Prophet at the time counselled them to forsake strange gods and prepare their hearts unto the Lord and serve Him only and they hearken unto him (I Samuel 7:1-6). Why was it easy for Samuel to convince them to serve God after so many years?
- When the Philistines attacked the children of Israel, Samuel prayed to God for help. Why was it easy for God to speedily hear and fight for them?
 - What do you think can make God fight your battle for you? Psalms 35:1-10
 - What is the meaning of Ebenezer according to the passage?
- The children of Israel also experienced restoration (verse 14), what must you do in order to experience restoration?
 - "And the hand of the Lord was against the Philistines all the days of Samuel", why was this so?

CONCLUSION: "But the Lord is the true God, He is the living God and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. Thus shall ye say unto them, the gods that have not made the heavens and the earth, even they shall perish from the earth and from under the heavens?" (Jeremiah 10:10- 11). "O Lord correct me, but with judgement; not in thine anger lest thou bring me to nothing." (Jeremiah 10:24). Let the Church pray this prayer. Amen.

PERSONAL ENEMY #1

Before they prayed, Bill related the story of how Abraham offered his son on the altar to God in obedience to God's command. Susan was encouraged to imagine herself kneeling before an imaginary altar and placing her clothes on the altar and dedicating them to God.

The following prayer was suggested: "Lord, right now I dedicate all my clothes to you. From this moment on they don't belong to me anymore but to you. You have the right as to how they are used. I'm responsible under you to take care of them."

Susan sincerely prayed this prayer. Then Bill told her she must purpose to thank God whatever the outcome. This would prove that she was sincere when she gave her clothes to God.

Bill explained to her that God has a right to test her sincerity and that He might test her sincerity by allowing her sister to wear the clothes and even to misuse them. He pointed out that the only change she could really count on was a change in herself.

Four days later, Susan returned with this enthusiastic report—"It works!"

"What works?" asked Bill.

"Giving my clothes to God!"

*I can hardly believe what happened. I didn't tell my sister anything about our talk, but since that time we haven't had one fight. She borrowed my clothes only once, and for the first time, she actually hung them up. She even ironed the blouse. I can't get over it!"**

Things worked out beautifully in this story. Susan's angry disposition was changed. And her sister changed too.

It doesn't always work out like this. Sometimes the other person does not change.

What happens then? If you are really sincere when you give your "rights" to God, YOU WILL CHANGE. If you've given your "rights" to God, you don't have anything to get mad about.



PRAYER POINTS


1. Every opposition that has risen against my jubilation this month be destroyed in Jesus name.

TURN BACK TO GOD

When One Door Closes, Another Opens



Trusting God when the door seems to be closing

With so much happening in the world today – the recession, job loss etc. it seems like all the doors are closing right in front of us. It seems like there's no way out of the situation we're in. We pray and pray (day and night) asking God to open up the windows of opportunity for us, but what do you do when all the doors seem to be closed? There's encouragement for you today.

When one door closes, another one opens

There are times when we pray and ask God for things. "God bless me with a job; give me that promotion at work; help me to pay my bills" etc. We ask God for a lot of things. However, we never ask God to open the doors which He wants to open and shut those which He wants to close. Today, I'm looking for a job and it seems as though every door is closing on me. Turned down after turned down after turned down. Then I realized that God has something better in store for me. My plans are not always His plans.

God has another plan for you

Sometimes the things we pray for are not the things God has in store for us. Oftentimes, we pray for little things when God wants to bless us with bigger ones. Sometimes we pray to God to bless us with the wrong things. I had to encourage myself and tell myself: when one door closes, another one opens.

You may be going through a situation right now feeling as though nothing is working out for your good. You might want to give up and throw the towel in. I want to encourage you today and tell you not to give up.

When God closes one door He opens up another. It could be that God wants you to have something else or be somewhere else in life. Or that God simply has another route for you to go down. Sometimes we have to hear NO in order to get to where God wants us to be. Sometimes door closes not because God is against us, but simply because it's used as a tool to guide us where God wants us to be.

When you feel as though you are losing hope, don't! Giving up, don't do it. Know that God is with you. Guiding and ordering your footsteps. He has a specific path just for you to travel down but sometimes, like children, we lose track and go down the wrong path. **Because of this, God put road blocks in the wrong paths to get us going down the right path.**

Conclusion

Be encouraged and know that God has the key to open every door; change every situation and open new windows of opportunities. Sometimes, road blocks are there to lead you to the path Jesus wants you to go; sort of like the yellow and white ink in the street guiding you as you drive to your destination.

Be encouraged and know that God does everything for a reason; not for our downfall, but for our good and to His glory. The road blocks we face is simply God guiding us. Be encouraged in Jesus name knowing that when one door closes, another opens. God bless you.

Life doesn't allow for us to go back and fix what we have done wrong in the past, but it does allow for us to **live each day better than our last.**

HOW LONG WILL YOU MOURN?

We are still fresh into the second half of the year, but are we still carrying a bit of baggage from the past year or months? Maybe a desperate prayer wasn't answered, or a promise you thought would be fulfilled in years or months didn't come to pass. Are you still mourning it?

God has given us a brand new second half of the year. Let us not carry our grief from the past year or months into the glorious second part of the year. Let us leave our pains, shame, lack, discouragement, disappointments, rejections, loneliness and sorrows in the past where they belong.

Let us move forward with joy and hope that God knows what's best for us. He will answer our prayers with His best; His promises for us will come to pass. God had a better king in mind for Israel and He has better plans for your future. Let's stop mourning and start rejoicing today!

IF GOD SAID IT, HE WILL DO IT!

Growing up, I had no Christian background or any great guidance about how to approach life. I witnessed a lot of violence from an early age. I got kicked out of school when I was 14 because I became violent and a bully. By the time I was 16, I was hanging around on the street, doing drugs, drinking lots and going to nightclubs. I started fighting and was getting arrested regularly and becoming known to the local authorities and police.

At 18, I was very violent and on a one-way street to prison. I started supplying drugs.

My father, who had boxed for England, said to me: "No more, you are now going to fight in the ring."

I became a good boxer quickly. In my first fight I beat my opponent in less than 30 seconds! I fought Joe Joyce, who competed for England at the Rio Olympics, as well as world heavyweight champion Anthony Joshua. Through the guys from the underworld, I started boxing unlicensed and became London's heavyweight unlicensed champion. I had such potential, but got more involved in drug use and dealing. I couldn't get out of the dark hole I'd got myself into over the years. No one showed me the light. I was totally out of control.-



SEEING THE LIGHT

After being arrested for serious assault, I bumped into Gary Flynn, an old friend who coordinates Street Pastors in Richmond. I told him what was happening in my life and he invited me to a men's breakfast, which I was reluctant to go to. At the breakfast there was a talk about anger management and I could feel the words absorbing into my mind. We talked about God, the Holy Spirit and the Bible and everything started to make sense. I couldn't believe I had never heard this before. A week later, I attended a church service and had an unbelievable, supernatural, overwhelming encounter with the Holy Spirit. I came away from there a different man, ready to do God's work. I started regularly attending Church of the Living God in Twickenham, and their pastor Zac came alongside me and taught me about Jesus and about grace.

SHARING THE LIGHT

As soon as I believed in Jesus, I instantly knew I needed to reach out to young people. I was just shocked no one had ever told me. I always wanted to teach boxing and I started to think I could use it to help kids. But my real plan was for salvation for young people. I knew this was what God wanted me to do and that my testimony would grab the hearts of troubled kids.

I started to help boxing clubs in Twickenham, but one day I was outside a bakery thinking: "I'd really like my own club" and I had this really strong thought: "Phone the Methodist church in Butts Farm." It was like a command. So I called Rev Vicci Davidson, who said: "This is wonderful. I have been praying for someone to come forward as we have just lost the staff for our senior youth club." As soon as I believed in Jesus, I instantly knew I needed to reach out to young people.

The church voted to let us use the church hall and to start with we just had hand pads, no equipment. We needed a boxing ring, which would cost £1,600, and I didn't have the money. One morning God spoke to me and said: "Just ask 15 brothers and sisters for £100 each." So I messaged people and everyone started sending cheques and the Methodist church hugely helped us in raising the funds, so we bought a brand new boxing ring within three weeks! Now we've also got bags on the wall, I've done my Amateur Boxing Association (ABA) coaching course, so I'm a professional coach, affiliated with the London ABA, and we have four boxing trainers, including my dad and Vicci's husband Mark.

I stop kids on the street and say: "Stop messing around and come to the boxing club. I'll teach you how to box." And we must have had 50 or 60 children from the estate come now. It's really lively on Friday and Monday evenings. The church has set up a juice bar, so after the boxing kids get free fruit drinks. I play Christian music at the beginning and end of the sessions. It's not the intention to start talking about God; the intention is to bring them off the street and give them training, even if they don't have the £3 for the session. Boxing is a tool to bring kids in and eventually share the gospel with them. Not many will compete, but boxing is good for their minds to keep them stable and fit, and the club has brought the community in; it's rebuilding it.

CHANGED LIVES

There are a few teenagers who have given their life to the Lord. One lad said that the church thing wasn't for him and then because one of the young guys from my church has started boxing and they'd become friends, he invited him to church and the other lad said: "Yeah," so I picked him up and we went to church. Then one day when I forgot to take him to church, he took himself there and gave his life to Christ when I wasn't even there!

Another kid started coming to the club who had never been to church before in his life. I was giving my testimony at the church where the boxing club is and he walked in! He tells me that he now prays and he regularly attends the Methodist church.

Butts Farm amateur boxing club has only been going six or seven months. Imagine when it's been going three or four years! Vicci is co-chair of the club and its chaplain. Recently, she had a long conversation with some of the boxers about how to pray, and provided those who wanted them with Gideon's Bibles. God's given us a great ministry. 
