

I then decided that, before I get angry with, or act Against, or judge anyone that has done something unfavourable to me, I will view it in at least three possible perspectives;
1. My own perspective,
2. His own perspective and
3. Others perspective'.

So, before you judge people, before you rage your anger on them, take a little time to view their angle or perspective, and, if you still cannot see a reasonable reason, then you may act **REASONABLY**.

I am writing this on a dreary day.
It's been raining on and off, and the sun is covered with a thick layer of grey clouds.

Some times in our lives feel like grey, dreary days, don't they?

Times of sickness.
Times of loneliness.
Times of disappointment.
Times of grief.

We worry that these times are never going to end. If you're anything like me, you let the dreary spiral down until it's all you can think about.

A pastor told me once that worrying is a sin. I don't know whether I believe that or not, but I do think that if we can learn to trust God more, we can learn to worry less.

It doesn't have to be that way. In fact, the Bible says that it *shouldn't* be that way:

Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

Philippians 4:8 (NIV)

For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline. *2 Timothy 1:7 (NIV)*

So if we are to think about whatever is excellent or praiseworthy and to do it in boldness... how?

How do you change from constant worry and stress to boldness, power, and self-discipline?

You pray. Pray that God will take away the timid spirit and the worry. Pray that you will be able to trust Him completely and see His goodness.

Because that's what worry is all about, is it not? You are not trusting God to do what is best for you and your family. It's a trust issue, not a worry issue.

Read that again: worry is a trust issue. You are not trusting God to be faithful and good to you.

The only way to shed that feeling, that belief, is to pray, read scripture, and learn to trust Him more. That's it.


Once we come to Christ we are on solid ground. All that David had was faith and a rock... and he defeated Goliath.



We are not merely turning over a new leaf; we are beginning a new life under a new master. God bless you for reading his word.



2. Second, believe what God says. So many people think that a person can earn salvation or make up for his sins by doing good things. We are not saved by what we do, but by what Jesus Christ did for us on the cross. You could do good things all your life and you would



never earn salvation. Over and over again in the Bible we are told that eternal life is a **gift**. The Bible says *"Because of his kindness [grace], you have been saved through trusting Christ. And even trusting is not of yourselves; it too is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good we have done, so none of us can take any credit for it."* (Ephesians 2:8-9, The Living Bible)

3. Third, receive Christ as your Saviour.

In order for a gift to be yours, you must receive it. God's Gift to us is His Son. Everything we need is in Him. But we must receive Him.

The Bible says, *"To all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God..."* (John 1:12)

Do you have a broken heart? Do you wonder if anybody understands you? Jesus does! Because He lived here as a man, Jesus Christ knows what it is like to be poor, to be lonely, to be misunderstood, to be rejected, to suffer, and to be tempted. 
